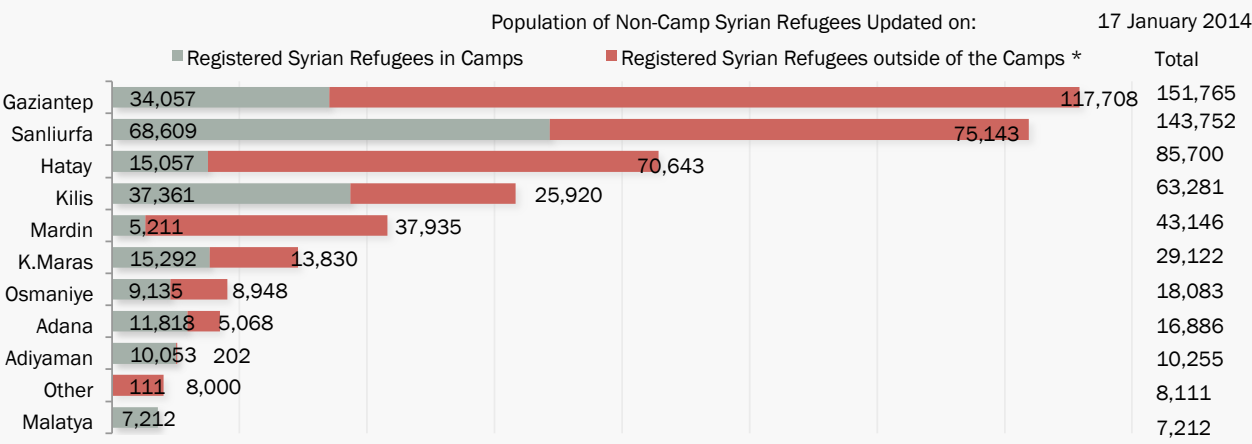
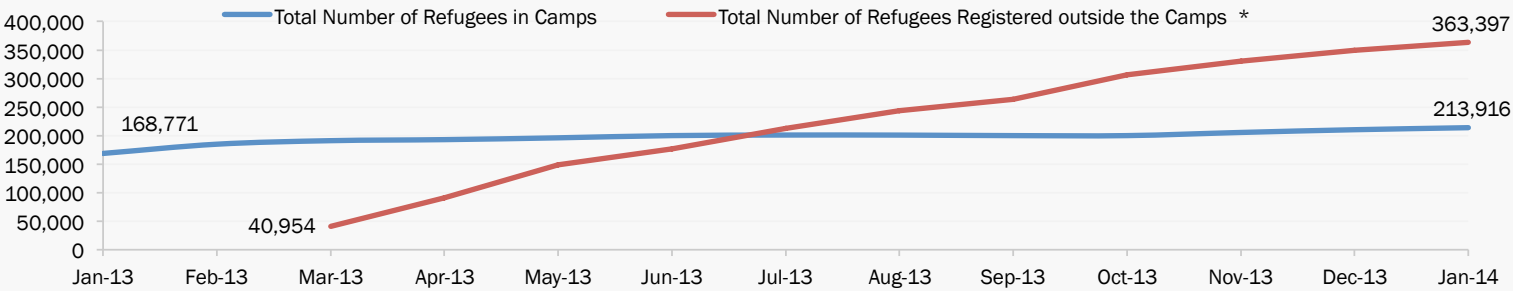

Highlights

- On 19 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 213,916 including 111 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 18-19 Jan 2014, a total of 371 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 390 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- On 17 January, the UNHCR High Commissioner and the Director of MENA Bureau visited Sanliurfa, Turkey to attend the Ministerial Coordination Meeting held in Harran container camp, participated by Lebanon, Jordan, Turkey, Iraq, Egypt and UNHCR. A joint statement was issued after the meeting, whereby all parties of the meeting appealed to the international community to boost solidarity with countries in the region that are hosting the majority of refugees fleeing the conflict in Syria.
- On 18 January, UNHCR organized a field visit to Nizip-1 (tent site) and Nizip-2 (container site) in Gaziantep Province for Ms. Maureen White, a private donor accompanied by UNHCR New York Office and UNHCR Turkey Office. The mission was warmly welcomed by the camp management in both camps. The visitors received briefing from the camp authorities, toured camp facilities (school, social facilities, market etc) and met with the refugee women's committee in Nizip-2 container site. In Nizip-1 tent site, the camp management raised the need to have prefab school as the education facilities are in rub-hall tents.
- The delivery of 316 WASH containers provided by UNHCR began in late December 2013, and is on-going in January 2013. To date, WASH containers have been delivered to Nusaybin camp (20), Hatay camps (9) and Adiyaman camp (5). The remaining 272 WASH containers are pending AFAD's instructions on the locations.
- In Viransehir Camp, local officials informed that as per instruction from AFAD Hq. they have started to register those (280 persons) who have been temporarily accommodated in the social facilities rub-halls. Reportedly the camp officials are also informed that another 250 have arrived during the weekend to the gate of the camp from Akcakale town will also be admitted. In addition, the camp officials stated that they have received authorization from AFAD Ankara that they some more people can be admitted which for which they will give the priority to the spontaneous arrivals who approach the gate and have immediate family members registered in the camp.
