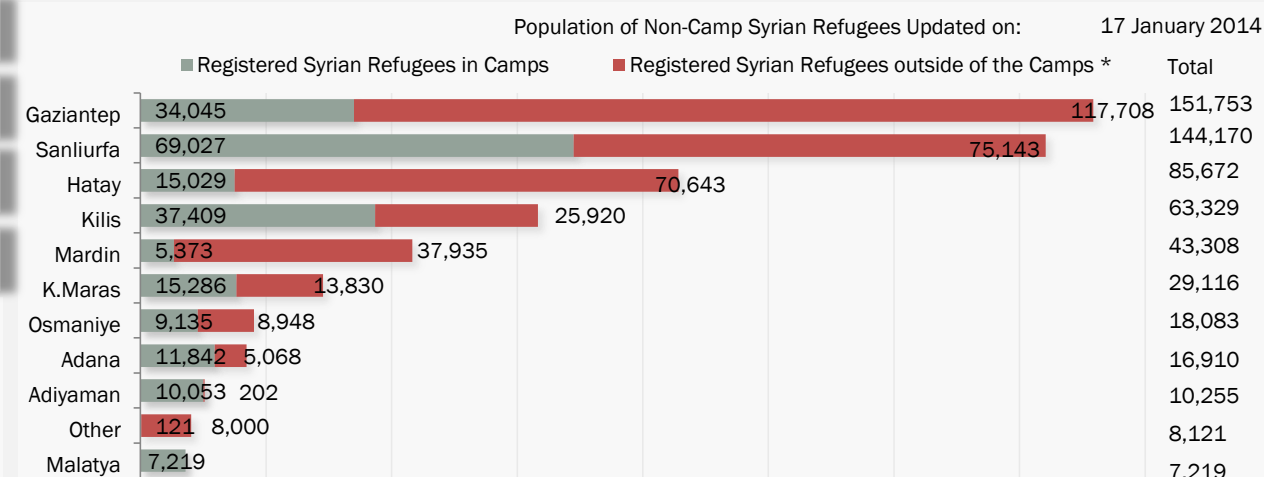
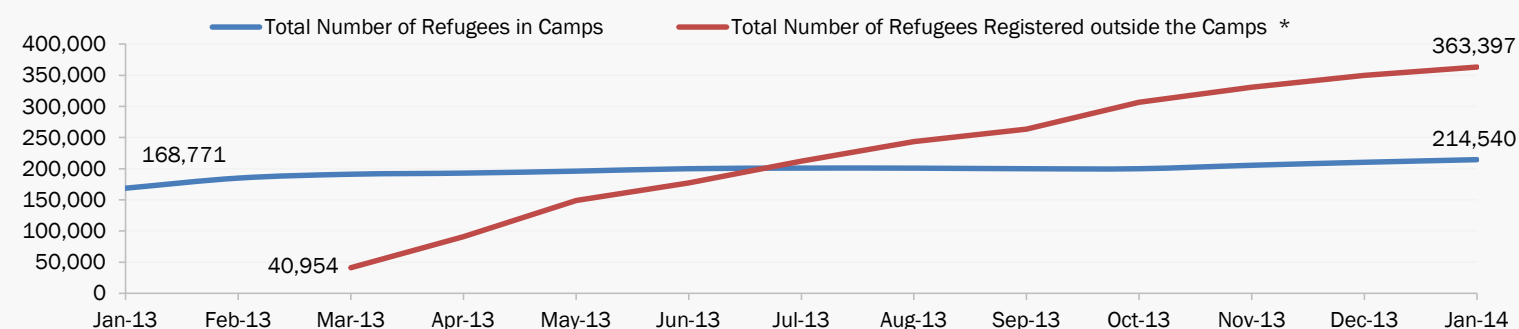

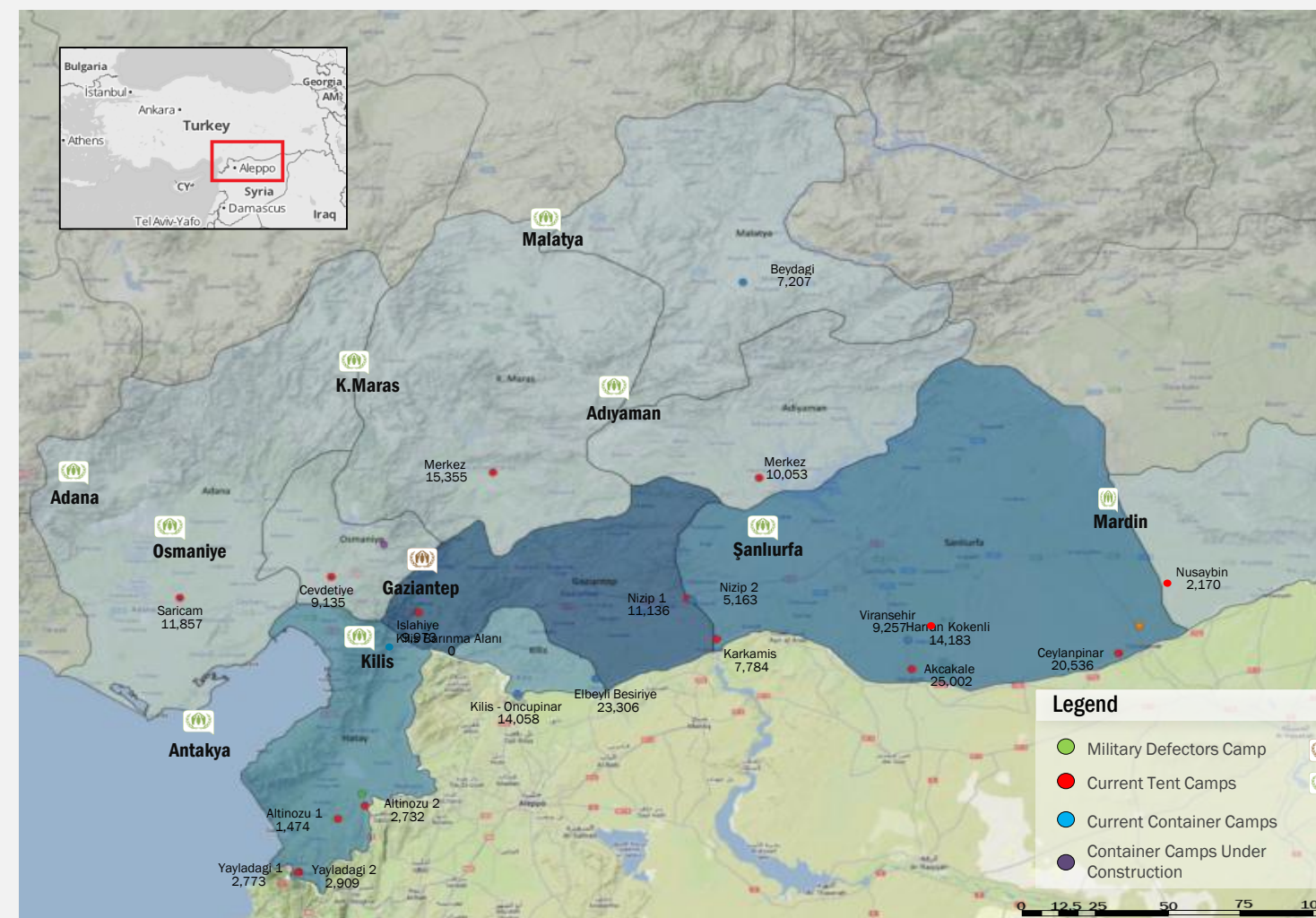

Highlights

- On 23 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 214,540 including 120 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 22-23 Jan 2014, a total of 303 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 302 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR Team was informed by the local officials that 1,440 persons who were admitted from Jarablus to Karkamis town have already been sent to Karkamis, Islahiye and Nizip-1 which all are tent camps. Reportedly 500 of them were sent to Islahiye camp, 512 were sent to Nizip-1 camp and about 400 were transferred to Karkamis camp temporarily until further instruction from AFAD.
- In order to accommodate these recent arrivals and considering the possible more new arrivals, UNHCR Field teams are informed by the local officials that the authorities are considering a new camp to be established. Reportedly the relevant officials are already searching available land in various provinces in the southeast.
- In Reyhanli UNHCR Field team observed that one of the mobile coordination units provided by UNHCR to AFAD has been deployed to Reyhanli and as of 22 Jan 2014, about 100 refugees have been registered. UNHCR was also informed that another mobile coordination unit was stationed in Akcakale town of Sanliurfa province but not operational yet.
- UNHCR continues to advocate for the refugees participation to the camp management. In Kahramanmaraş UNHCR staff participated to the Women Committee meeting. The discussion points were early marriage and domestic violence. The committee members suggested to organize activities to raise awareness against both issues.
- UNHCR is funding several prefabricated clinics to be established in various urban locations and camps in the South East (Sanliurfa, Adiyaman, Kilis, Gaziantep and Kahramanmaraş). UNHCR Public Health Officer met with local officials and discussed technical issues related to these prefabricated clinics.
