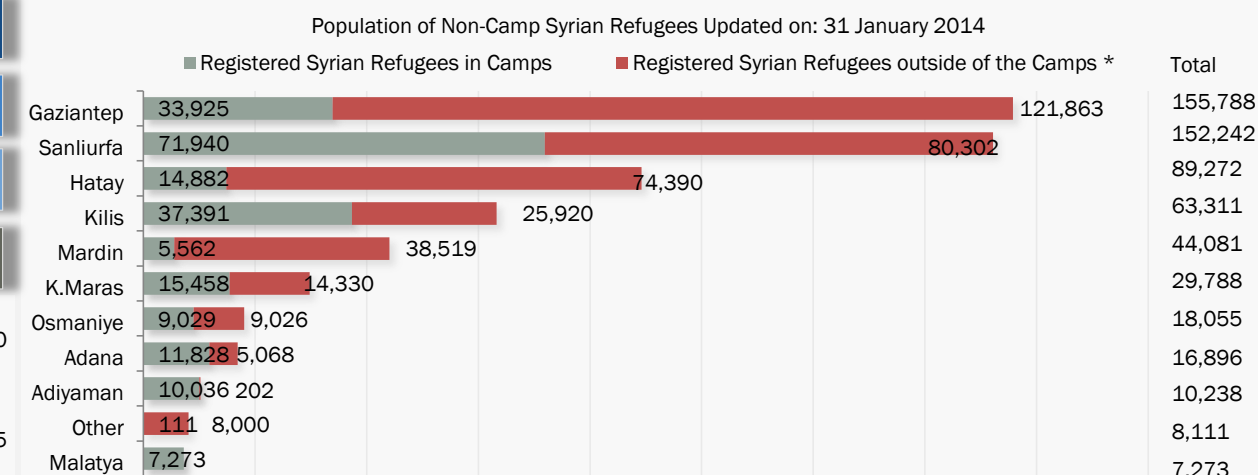
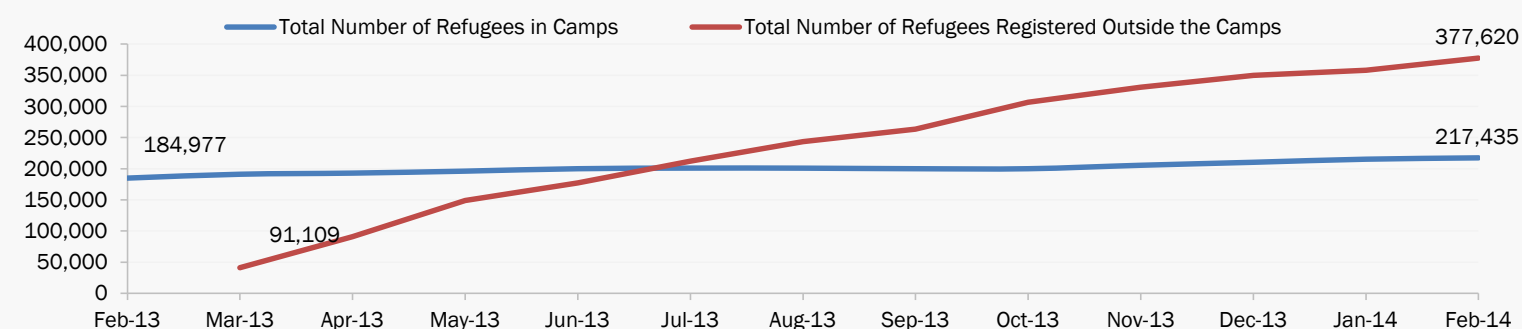

Highlights

- On 06 February 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 217,435 including 111 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 05-06 Feb 2014, a total of 460 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 259 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- According to reports from two villages near Elbeyli, on a daily basis hundreds of Syrians are crossing the border informally, passing through the villages and taking the buses to other provinces like Gaziantep. Adana etc.. It is reported that villagers sometimes provide one night accommodation in their village to the refugees. Also, some of the villagers are reported to provide bread on a daily basis to send across the border as they hear there are many displaced people in the villages on the Syrian side.
- Camp officials in Viransehir informed UNHCR that about 600 Syrians spontaneously arrived to the camp gate stating they came from Kilis and requested to be admitted to the camp. The new-arrivals are temporarily accommodated in the waiting area in rub hall tents and provided with hot meals. The officials informed that they are admitting the immediate family members of the camp residents while for the others they have been in contact with AFAD Hq and waiting for confirmation for their admission to Viransehir camp or transfer to the Nusaybin camp.
- In addition to the spontaneous arrivals from Kilis, the Viransehir camp management informed that they have been instructed by AFAD HQ to accept 39 Syrians from Balikesir to arrive during the weekend and also during the week another 109 Syrians were admitted from Harran town as per instruction from AFAD. As of Thursday 06 Feb. Viransehir camp population increased to over 12,000.
- According to the registration unit of Adiyaman camp, the number of non-camp Syrians in Adiyaman province is also increasing. The officials stated that about 300 are already enumerated in the city center however in total there may be 600 or more including those staying with their relatives in villages.
