

Highlights

- On 10 February 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 217,759 including 105 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 09-10 Feb 2014, a total of 229 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 147 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR Field Team visited the sea port officials in Mersin Tasucu. The officials informed that during the year of 2013, about 14,299 Syrians have arrived to Turkey by sea from Lebanon (Tripoli) and Syria (Tartus) while 9,584 Syrians returned to Syria and Lebanon. During the month of Jan 2014, 1,451 Syrians came to Turkey and 552 Syrians returned to Syria and Lebanon.
- AFAD reported that, during the month of Jan 2014, more than 14,000 Syrians and during the first 9 days in Feb 2014, more than 4,400 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps. Local officials in Kilis and Reyhanli informed UNHCR that on a daily basis 500-1000 Syrians with passports are crossing to Turkey from Kilis Oncupinar border gate, while another 900-1000 Syrians with passports are crossing from Cilvegözü border gate. In addition to all these official admissions, UNHCR also received reports from villages along Kilis border, that there are several hundreds of Syrians crossing to Turkey from unofficial crossing points along the border line and find their ways to other destinations.
- It was reported by the local officials in southeast province that they are also receiving more new arrivals approaching for registration. In Kahramanmaraş province the local officials informed that they have already registered about 19,000 non camp Syrians were registered in Kahramanmaraş and about more than 2,000 Syrians were issued ikamet (temporary residence permit) within Kahramanmaraş. The camp manager of Kahramanmaraş camp informed the UNHCR Field team that during the month of Jan 2014, about 600 new arrivals have been admitted to the camp.
- The camp manager in Kahramanmaraş informed UNHCR team that during the month of Jan 2014, about 832 families arrived in the city. It was also reported that with the participation of staff from the camp and local administrators (mukhtars) as well as the staff (imams) from the mosques are working jointly to identify the new arrivals and depending on their vulnerability and needs, the governorate is providing non-food items
