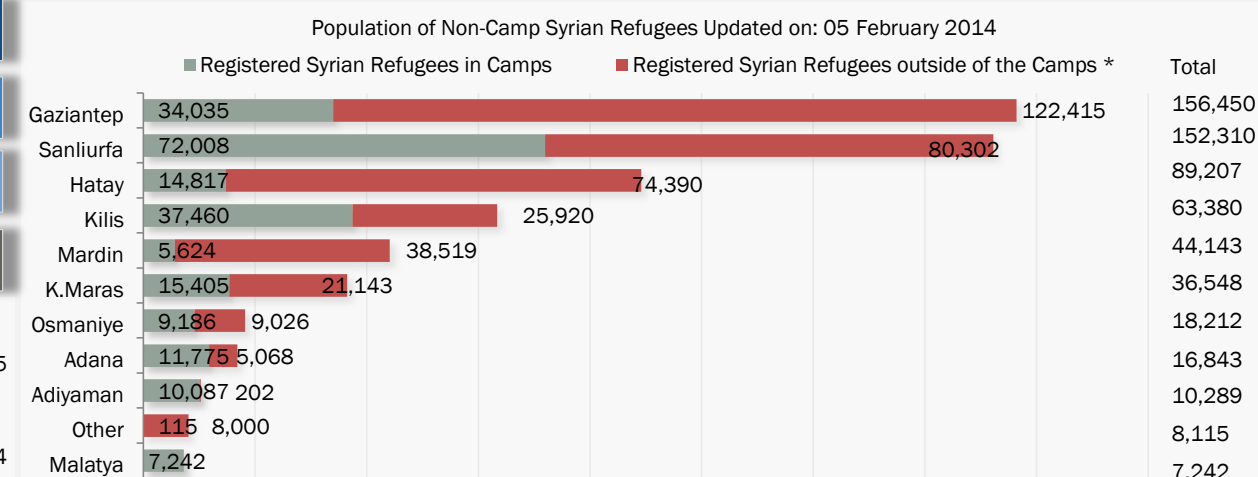
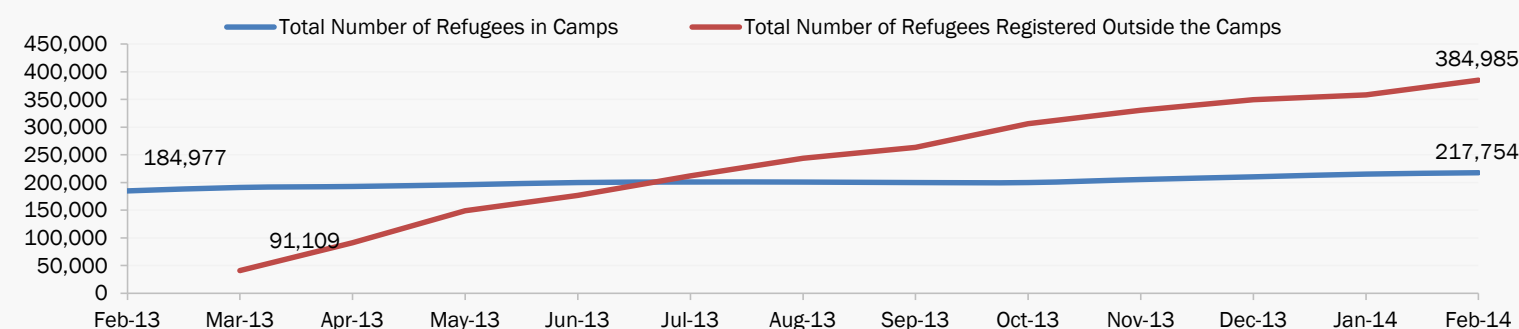

Highlights

- On 12 February 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 217,754 including 115 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 10-12 Feb 2014, a total of 989 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,157 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Viransehir camp, camp officials informed UNHCR that out of the 900-1,000 Syrians currently accommodated in rub halls in the waiting area, 352 have been transferred to Nusaybin camp on 12 Feb. 2014. The camp officials stated that they are waiting for instructions from AFAD Hq to transfer all others to Nusaybin or another camp where space is available.
- In Viransehir, with the instruction of the sub-governor, one of the Social Counselors from the Counseling and Research Center assigned to the camp has conducted a training on "Effective Communication and Anger Management" for the private security company guards working in the camp. 165 guards in the camp attended the training. The counselor will also work on identifying unaccompanied minors and separated children.
- The Mobile Coordination Center for registration of non-camp Syrians in Reyhanli has been operational since mid Januray and as of 11 February 2014, more than 4,000 Syrians have been registered and finger-printed. The Head of Security in Reyhanli informed that they are hoping to complete the registration of Syrian refugees in Reyhanli town center in a few months and will then start the registration of those in rural areas/ villages.
- A UNHCR Field Team visited the transit center in Reyhanli located on the way to Cilvegozu customs border gate. The officials informed that on a daily basis they are processing the voluntary return of more than 200 persons spontaneously approaching and requesting to return to Syria. During the last 2 days more than 550 Syrians voluntary return was processed and facilitated through the transit center. The officials in the center informed that sometimes they also refer Syrians as they no longer can afford to live in the urban areas in Reyhanli and who request to be accommodated in a camp.
