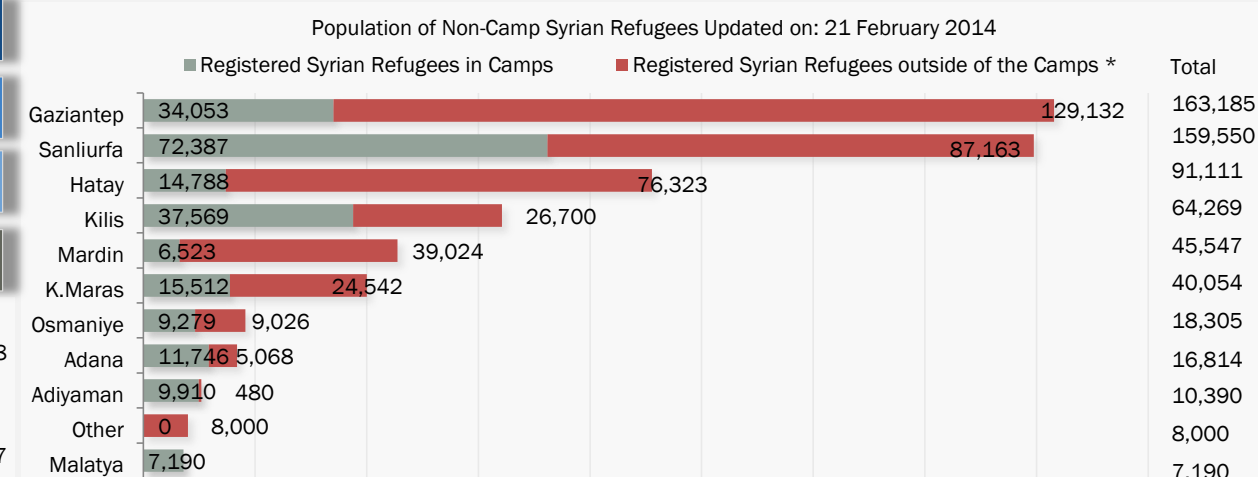
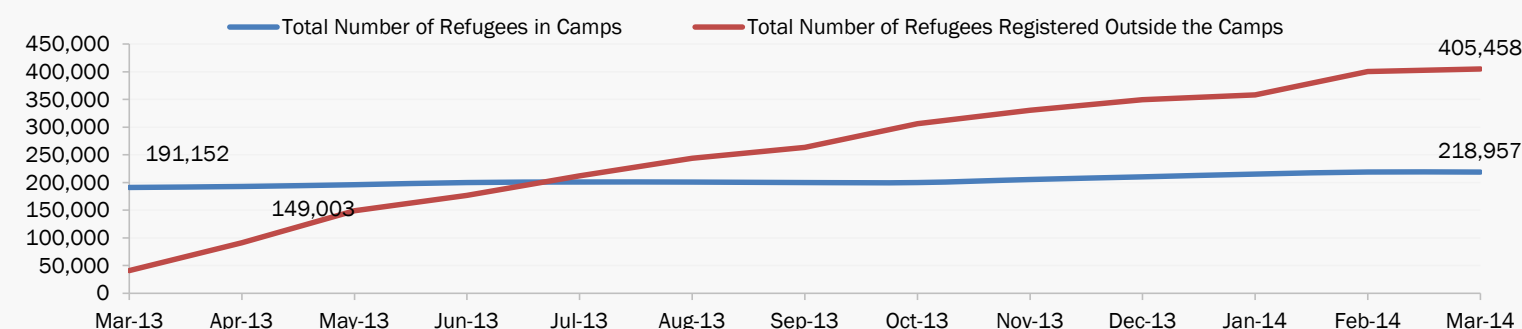


Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	624,415

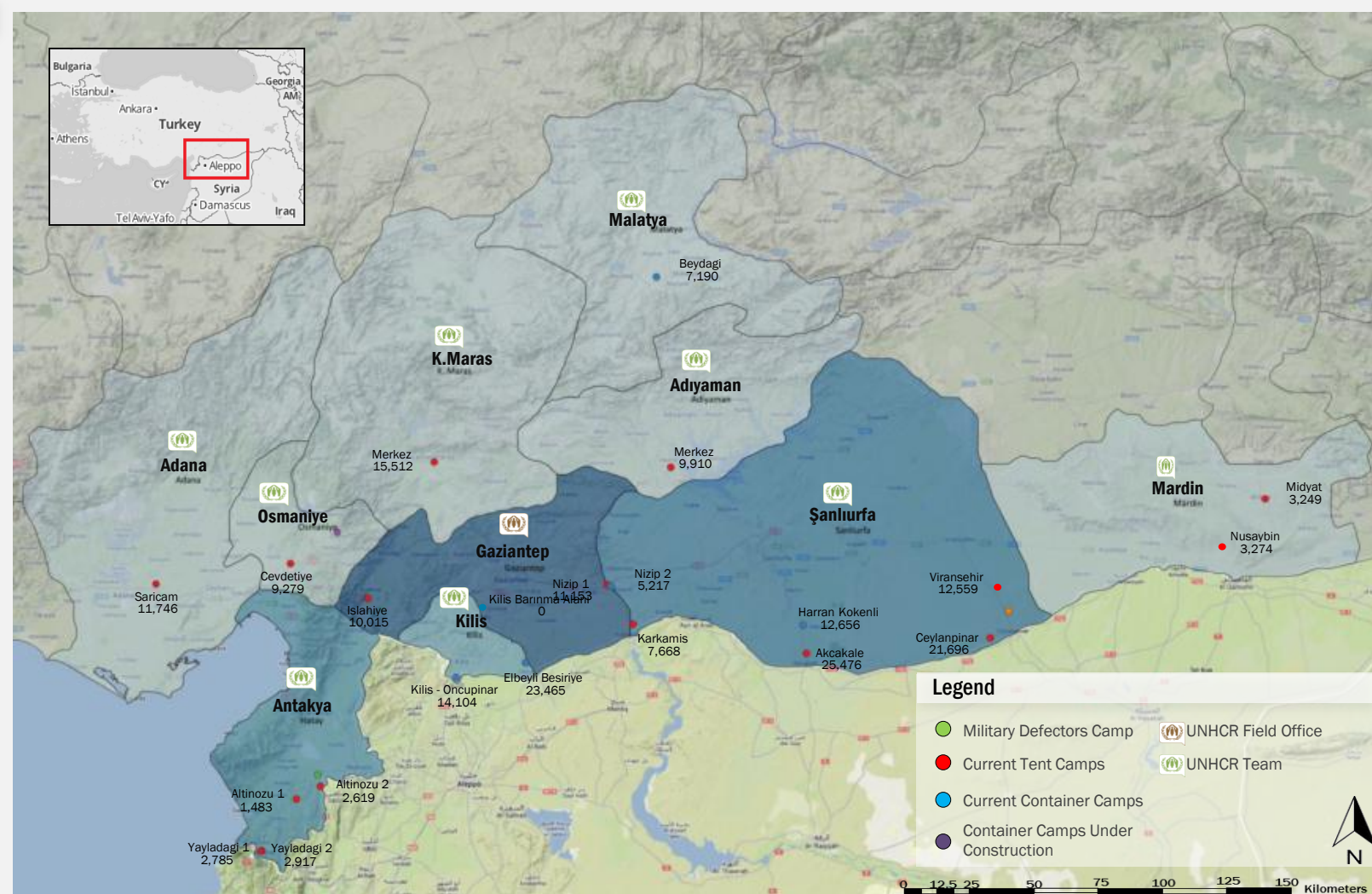


Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 03 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 218,957. AFAD reported that during the period of 02-03 March 2014, a total of 494 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 327 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- According to the official figures from the local officials and AFAD, as of end of Feb 2014, the number of non-camp Syrians registered and enumerated in 10 provinces is almost two times more than the total number of Syrians in the camps. When compared to end of Dec. 2013, there is an increase of 4% in the total number of Syrians in the camps and about 16% increase in the non-camp Syrians registered and enumerated in 10 provinces.
- During the previous week, Adiyaman camp management reported to UNHCR that another 100 Syrians approached the camp to be admitted. However due to shortage of space in the camp, they could not be admitted and were temporarily accommodated in the rub hall in the waiting area until further instruction from AFAD Hq for their transfer to possibly to Nusaybin camp. This brought the total number of Syrians in the waiting area of Adiyaman camp to 230 persons.
- The camp management of Adiyaman initiated a carpentry course for men as part of their vocational courses. Reportedly the capacity of the classroom is for a maximum of 60 people while the number of interested applicants is 10 times fold. While the camp management is working on identification/selection among the applicants, they are also in contact with a charity who can support the camp on equipment etc.
- In Akcakale local officials informed that they have established a tent school in Akcakale town for the children of non-camp Syrians living in town. Reportedly about 31 tents provided by UNICEF to the camp management in Akcakale were put in town. Local authorities also identified about 170-200 Syrians teachers and already some 600-650 children were registered to attend the classes.
