





## Highlights

- On 09 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,639. AFAD reported that during the period of 07-09 March 2014, a total of 1,484 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 852 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Viransehir camp officials informed that all the spontaneous arrivals who have been waiting at the camp gate in the rub hall tents (approximately 700-750 persons) have been transferred to Nusaybin camp during last week. Nusaybin camp officials confirmed the arrival of the transferred refugees and Nusaybin camp population was reported as 4,164 on 09 March 2014 by AFAD, which includes the increase of more than 800 new admissions to the camp during the weekend.
- In Mardin, there is only one school for the children of non-camp Syrians. There are 6 classrooms with 14 Syrian Teachers where about 225 children are attending from 1-9 grades. In addition to the Syrian teachers who are teaching the Syrian curriculum, a Turkish volunteer is also providing Turkish language classes. The school is supported by an NGO which also provides support to 5 schools (2 in Gaziantep, 1 in Kiziltepe, 1 in Mardin city center and 1 in Istanbul) for Syrian children.
- UNHCR Field Team was informed that the same NGO also approached to the Sub-Governorate of Ceylanpinar and requested space to be allocated to open another school for non-camp Syrian children in Nusaybin. The NGO pays about 500 TL per month as an incentive to all the Syrian teachers in their schools.
- In Kilis DRC - the Danish Refugee Council informed UNHCR that they have so far assessed the vulnerability of about 4,000 families and another 2,000 families are planned to be completed in the coming weeks. Reportedly about 30% of the people assessed have their AFAD ID Cards issued upon registration by the local authorities. DRC also reported that they have started the distribution of NFIs.
