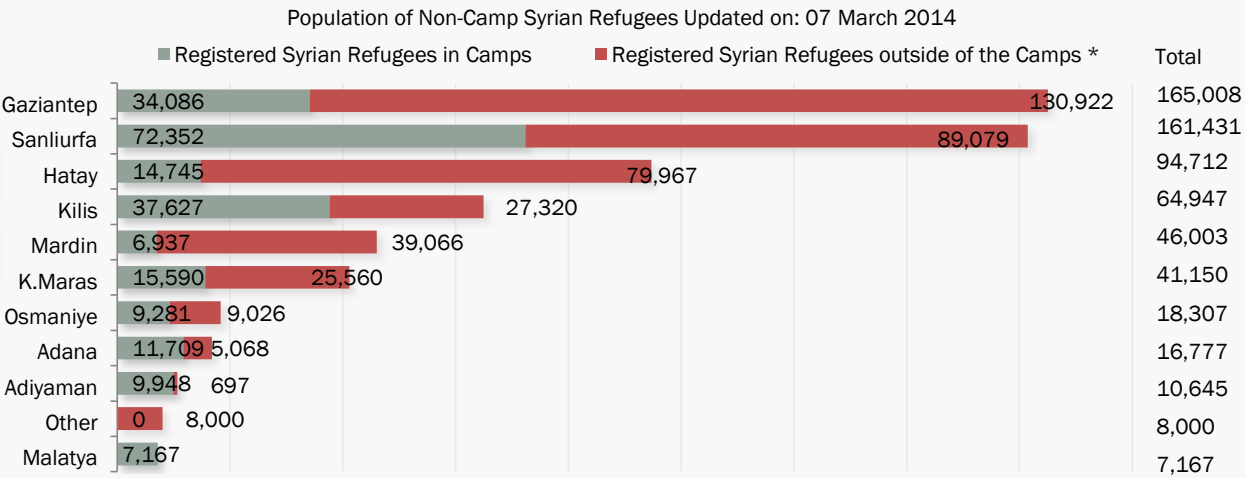
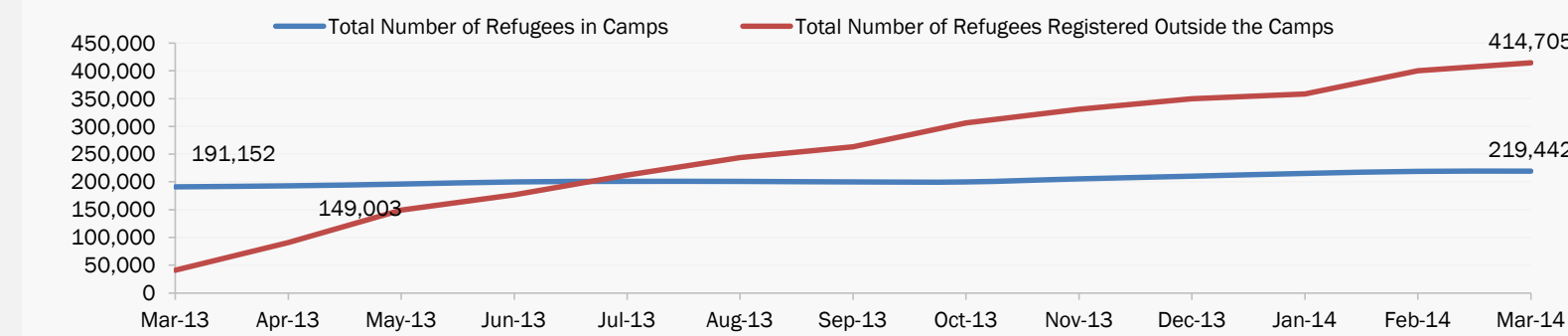


Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	634,147

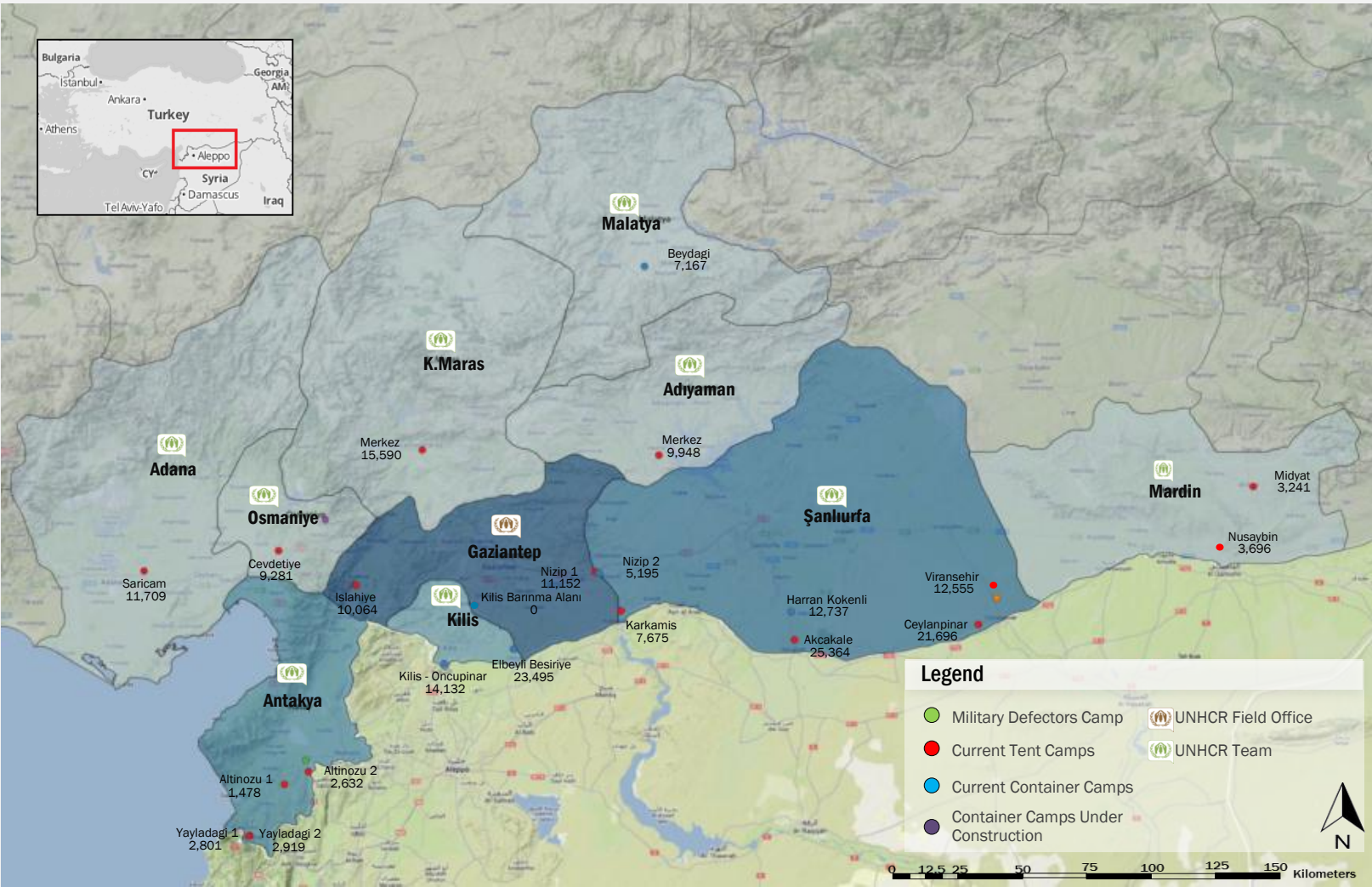


Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 10 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,442. AFAD reported that during the period of 09-10 March 2014, a total of 127 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 324 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Adiyaman the camp management informed that during the past weekend, 227 Syrians who approached the camp spontaneously (individually or in smaller groups) and who were temporarily accommodated in the waiting area, have been transferred to Nusaybin camp upon authorization from AFAD Ankara. The group had been waiting at the gate of the camp for the last few weeks, but could not be admitted due to shortage of space in the camp.
- Around 545 Syrians who were transferred to the Nizip-1 tented camp during last week, are still being accommodated in rub-hall tents and are being provided 3 meals day and emergency medical assistance when needed. Camp officials informed UNHCR that through the Sub-Governorate of Nizip, AFAD Ankara was informed and they are waiting for authorization to transfer them to another camp.
- One of the two mobile coordination units in Gaziantep has been placed in Islahiye camp and as of 10 March 2014, started to register non-camp Syrians living in Islahiye and its villages. Officials informed that due to technical reasons the unit was placed in the camp. According to both officials and a local NGO, there are more than 10,000 non-camp Syrians living in Islahiye town center and its villages. Gaziantep AFAD informed that the second mobile coordination unit will be placed in Nizip when they prepare the technical requirements.
- In Adana the officials informed that they have received one of the mobile registration units and are preparing the technical equipment and arrangement of the staff. Officials reported that there are more than 5,000 Syrians living in Adana with ikamets (temporary residence permits), however they estimate that the number of Syrians living in Adana is much higher and may be up to 30,000.
