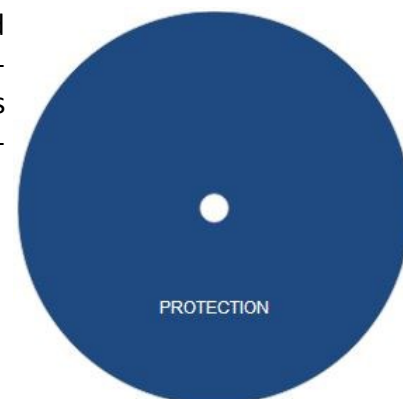




Terre des hommes Lausanne (Tdh-L)

Mission

Since its creation in 1960, the mission of Terre des hommes Lausanne (Tdh-L) has been to come to the aid of children in need. It endeavors at all times to defend the rights of children, in times of war and natural disasters, or in less publicized situations of distress. Today, Tdh-L is a significant force among children's aid organizations in Switzerland and throughout the world. It is the largest NGO for children's aid in Switzerland. Active in 34 countries, Tdh-L develops and implements field projects to allow a better daily life for over one million children and their close relatives, particularly in the domains of health care and child protection.



In 2014, Tdh-L has appealed for a total of **USD 1,282,160**

Objective 2: Community empowerment, engagement, outreach and self-reliance is strengthened and expanded, and WGBM are engaged in the planning, implementation & evaluation of services.

Output 2.1 Community based protection mechanisms, outreach and community mobilization strengthened. **USD 12,900**

Output 2.5 Psychosocial support services are strengthened and expanded. **USD 873,730**

Objective 4: Emergency child protection interventions for boys & girls are strengthened & harmonized.

Output 4.1 Capacity development and collaboration with relevant stakeholders is strengthened, including through the mainstreaming of child protection into other humanitarian response sectors. **USD 71,150**

Output 4.2 CP prevention activities are increased, including through the strengthening of CBCPCs and other community structures. **USD 151,615**

Output 4.3 Procedures and coordination mechanisms, including SOPs and referral mechanisms, are established and strengthened in order to support early disclosure, identification and referral in a safe & confidential manner. **USD 86,575**

Output 4.4 Quality of multi-sectoral response services of girls and boys and their families is strengthened and improved in accordance with AGD principles. **USD 86,190**

In 2014, Tdh-L is implementing for UN agencies who have also appealed under the RRP6. This includes Unicef in the sector of child protection.
