



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	<b>679,843</b>

## Highlights

- On 08 April 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 223,731. AFAD reported that during the period of 07-08 April 2014, a total of 158 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 225 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local officials in Batman confirmed that they have received the Mobile Coordination Center which was initially sent to Mardin Nusabin but later was transferred to Batman. Provincial AFAD Officials informed that they are still working on some technical requirements for the registration and expecting the Center to be operational in the coming weeks.
- Local authorities in Batman informed UNHCR that the estimated number of Syrians in Batman is more than 20,000, most of whom are living in the city center while some few thousands may be in the surrounding villages. Of this estimation, about 18,000 have been enumerated and registered by the local officials and about 1,200 have been issued ikamets (temporary residence permit). Local officials informed that in addition to the medical assistance for Syrians they are providing food packages and core relief items (blankets, clothing and hygiene packages etc.).
- In Mardin Midyat, the Assyrian Association informed UNHCR that they have been providing food vouchers to non-camp Assyrians from Syria living in Midyat for the last 6 months with the donations they received from their community in US. Reportedly they have assisted about 222 families with approximately 75 TL per person per month. However depending on the vulnerability of the beneficiaries some families/individuals were paid more. The association informed that based on their assessments, their donor will decide whether or not to continue the donations.
- In Nusaybin, local officials stated that the estimated number of Syrians living outside of camps in Nusaybin is about 10- 12,000 while they also estimate that there are several hundreds moving to/from Syria on a weekly basis through official and unofficial crossing points. Some vulnerable Syrians are assisted through SASF - Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation, with
