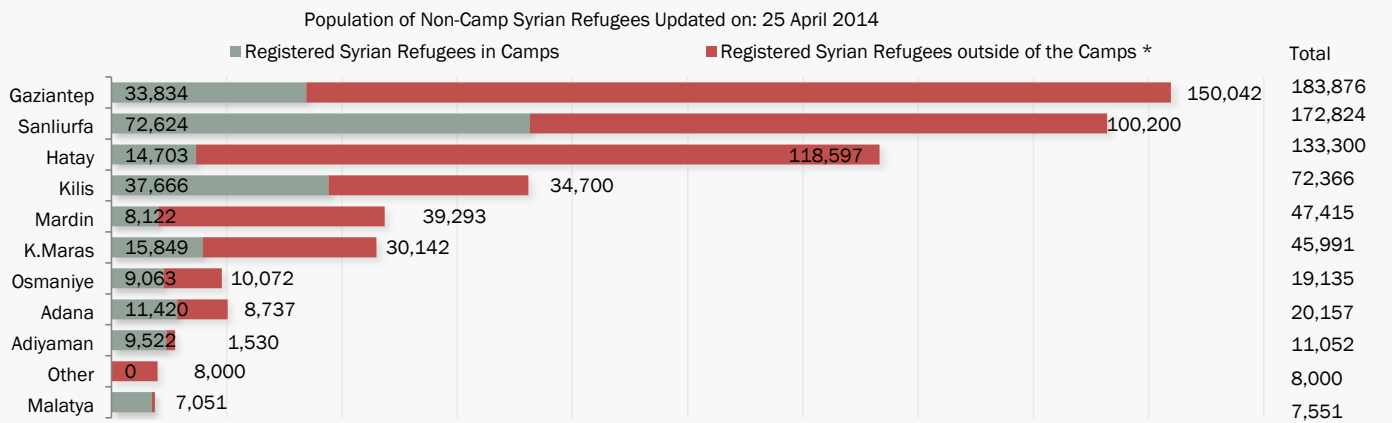
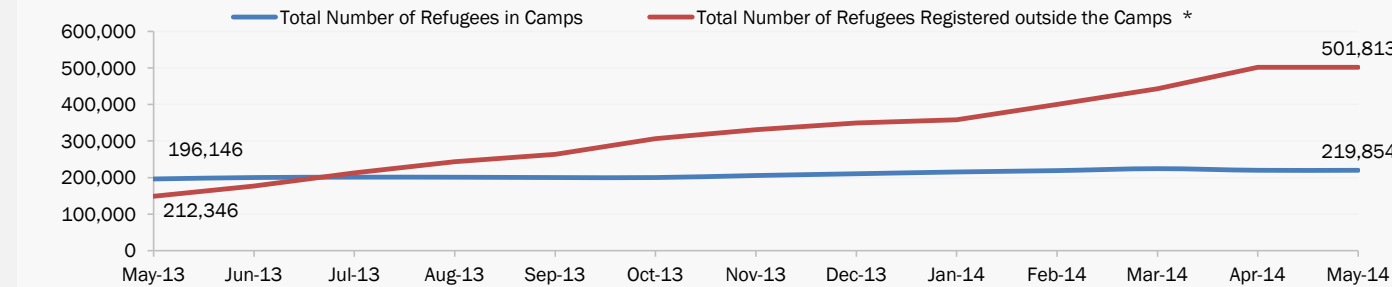
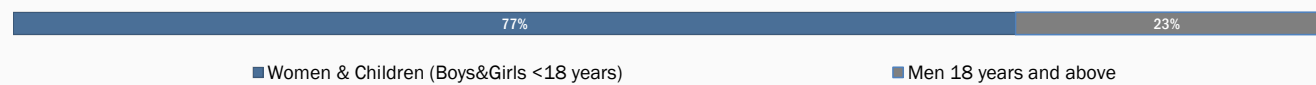

## Highlights

- On 01 May 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219.854 AFAD reported that during the period of 30 April-01 May 2014, a total of 52 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 298 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Ceylanpinar the local authorities informed that during last week about 100 Syrians approached the border near Ceylanpinar town due to the increased fights and they were all admitted to Turkey. Reportedly the new arrivals chose not to go to any camp, but stay with their relatives in urban in Ceylanpinar town and surrounding villages.
- In Ceylanpinar, the local authorities informed that they have allocated one of the buildings formerly used for Social Support Projects (SODES) for the local community to be used as a school for non-camp Syrian children. An NGO called International Association of Compassion will provide furniture to this urban school and will also provide local transportation for the Syrian children living in Ceylanpinar town as well as the incentives for Syrian teachers who will be working in the school.
- In Islahiye camp officials stated that they have started the renovation of the water-sanitation system including the toilets and showers. The camp management stated that they will be receiving 300 container toilets and showers to replace the existing ones. During last week UNHCR observed that 12 container toilets and 6 shower container units had already arrived at the camp.
- The camp officials in Islahiye also informed UNHCR that the existing water source of the camp is from the neighboring settlements around the camp. In order to increase water capacity and to avoid possible water shortage in the future, The camp management is discussing with the municipality of Islahiye to open an additional water borehole for the camp only.
- According to the camp officials, there are about 81 people currently accommodated in the waiting area of Islahiye camp. The camp officials stated that they are doing their best to accommodate these people in the tents of those who departed spontaneously and did not show up and they are also planning to put up some additional tents to accommodate them in the camp.
