



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	743,130

Highlights

- On 13 May 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,610. AFAD reported that during the period of 12-13 May 2014, a total of 347 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 238 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Upon request from Nusaybin camp management, UNHCR delivered 500 mini fridges to the camp. This will support the food card system which is currently implemented through AFAD, and is to be included in WFP/Kizilay program as of June 2014. Previously over 800 fridges UNHCR provided and sent from Kizilay warehouses. In addition to the fridges, UNHCR sent 3,644 sets of clothes for children between 2 and 17 years.
- UNFPA informed that upon request from the camp officials, they have delivered 6,000 hygiene kits (one set per family) to three camps: Islahiye (2,500 kits), Adiyaman (2,500 sets) and Mardin/Midyat camp (1,000 sets). UNFPA informed that should there be further requests they will consider to provide kits to other camps.
- Viransehir camp officials informed that during the previous week, they have received about 100 Syrians from Ceylanpinar following instructions from AFAD. Reportedly the 100 Syrians were living in Ceylanpinar in town and surrounding villages and were sent in two groups.
- In Viransehir, the head of education unit informed that they have started the ground work for the second prefab school. As soon as the ground work is completed, the construction of the school donated by UNICEF will start. The school will consist of 12 classrooms and is expected to be completed in one month. As the current academic year will finish by 20th of May the school will be used as from the next semester.
- In Adana Saricam camp, the officials informed UNHCR that they have distributed clothing to all camp residents. Reportedly the items were a private donation including both new and second hand clothes and shoes. Each family was provided about 24 pieces of various types of clothing.
