



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	795,726

Highlights

- On 02 July 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,154. AFAD reported that during the period of 01-02 July 2014, a total of 485 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 283 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- On 02 July 2014, AFAD reported that the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps exceeded half a million (500,193) persons since the beginning of the crisis and reportedly more than 281,000 of them were de-registered from the camp records for various reasons. These included voluntary returns to Syria and/or spontaneous departures from camps without return. AFAD also reported that since the beginning of the crisis, more than 3 million in-patient/out patient medical services were provided to Syrians.
- Local officials in Sanliurfa informed UNHCR that they have received 2,550 food packages and 500 hygiene kits from AFAD provided by an INGO. These have been distributed to the non-camp Syrians living in Sanliurfa city center, Akcakale, Ceylanpinar and Viransehir towns and surrounding villages. In Viransehir, the camp management also informed that they have received shoes from a Turkish NGO for all the female residents of the camp. It was also reported that MSF donated about 150 food packages which were distributed to residents of Akcakale camp.
- Upon request from the camp management and the provincial AFAD Directorate in Gaziantep, UNHCR provided 55 mini fridges to Islahiye camp to the families who have been admitted to the camp and accommodated in the additional tents which were established during the renovation of all the tents in the camp. When food assistance in the camp was switched to WFP-Kizilay card-voucher system of last year, UNHCR provided a total of 1,800 mini fridges to Islahiye camp.
- In Hatay a local NGO (HAYAD - Hatay Assistance Association) is providing various types of assistance (food packages, NFIs, and medical) to non-camp Syrians in the towns of Hatay when they get request from the local officials. Since the beginning of Ramadan, they are providing iftar (evening meal during Ramadan) to 1,000 Syrians every day in Kirikhan. The NGO also informed that upon request from their volunteers in the towns they also send 500 loaves of bread to be distributed to non-camp Syrians.
