




Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	822,149

Highlights

- On 14 August, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 217,280. AFAD reported that from 13 to 14 August, a total of 951 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 437 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- It was reported in the national media that as precautionary measure to reduce the tensions between the Syrians and local communities, Syrians considered to disturb public order and those begging and living in parks and the streets, will be transferred to the camps. In Mardin officials informed UNHCR that they received the instruction that some of these Syrians will be sent to Nusaybin camp.
- In Nizip 1 and Nizip 2 camps officials informed that they had about 187 Syrians (106 in Nizip-1 and 81 in Nizip-2) have registered for the Turkish Language classes of TOMER for the next academic year. Camp officials also stated that in addition there are about 35 students who have applied to Gaziantep University of whom 15 already had the proficiency certificate in Turkish language from TOMER and the other 20 have provided the accreditation of their high school diplomas which they submitted to the university and waiting for reply.
- In Nizip 1 and Nizip 2 camp officials stated that the German Red cross donated the hygiene kits including the baby diapers to the camp and the packages were distributed to the families (1 package per family) during the week. The representatives of the German red cross were also in the camp to observe the distribution of the packages.
