304,693 Syrian refugees registered in 2014

CHILD PROTECTION and SGBV RESPONSE

SHELTER

293,625 persons assisted with shelter interventions

WASH

120,692 individuals provided with storage containers

PUBLIC HEALTH

616,275 primary health care consultations in 2014

EDUCATION

140,609 6 -15year old children enrolled in formal education
