### 1) Updates from Field WGs and Task Forces

Zaatari and Azraq:

- Referral Coordination meeting took place to discuss possible revisions to Referral Forms in order to improve services provision.
- Additional meetings to be scheduled in both camps for the following week.

Azraq:

- TORs for Azraq Protection (CP+SGBV) WG were endorsed on July the 16th.

Task forces:

- UASC TF: common tracking sheet UNHCR/UNICEF to get better overview in Jordan for both camps and host communities.
- Formalisation of Alternative Care Guidelines Procedures signed between UNICEF-UNHCR and the Ministry of Social Development. To be shared with TF at the next meeting.

**2) Presentation on Gender Analysis of RRP reporting by Merrin Waterhouse, Senior Gender Capacity Advisor to the IATF & HCT, Jordan.** Activity info performance indicators: disaggregation of data reveals that access to services – including Safe Spaces – by beneficiaries is not equitable. CFS service providers to conduct FGDs to identify the reasons behind girls' low attendance of CFS and come up with a strategy to address this. Target: UNHCR to share plan at CP SWG meeting on August the 17<sup>th</sup>.

3) **Presentation on project selection criteria for PSS by Frank Roni (UNICEF):** Presentation of PSS guidelines, aimed at harmonising the provision of psychosocial services between organisations. Shift from traditional Emergency response to Resiliency-building approach to psychosocial wellbeing and child protection. Presentation to be shared with organisations.

4) **AoB**

a) Mercy Corps' No Lost Generation programmes in Mafraq, Irbid and Ajlun: adolescent and CFSs to open in March 2015 (target of 12 000 boys and girls). Organisations to be invited to take part in the project. Organisations asked to provide mapping of their CFSs.
