



Highlights

- On 25 August, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 218,786. AFAD reported that from 24 to 25 August, a total of 200 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 220 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- A UNHCR team met with a Turkish NGO who is running a center for orphans from Syria. The center is able to accommodate 60 children and is currently hosting 21 (11 girls and 10 boys), all under the age of 12 years old. The center's five caretakers are all volunteers. The center is in contact with the provincial authorities and provincial directorate of AFAD in Kilis, as well as the provincial directorate of family and social policies.
- UNHCR Team visited the Palestinians coming from Syria accommodated in a warehouse repurposed to host families, tents and containers. The Palestinian Committee and local authorities are supporting around 500 Palestinians. Reportedly, all are registered and have been through a medical screening conducted by the provincial health directorate. The children have been vaccinated and are attending informal classes organized by the group.
- UNICEF informed UNHCR that, in consultation with the camp officials, they will provide containers to be used as libraries for 13 camps. These library containers will be provided fully furnished including five laptop computers and books. The camps with space problem or that already have libraries will be provided with furniture and books. The items are planned to be delivered in the coming weeks. UNICEF is also in contact with the camp officials in Elbeyli for the construction of a prefabricated structure to be used as social activity center. The construction is planned to start in September.
- In Adana Saricam Camp, officials informed UNHCR that they have about 72 Syrians temporarily accommodated in the waiting area. Camp officials reported that some of them are refugees who had left the camp with permission but never returned, some have extended family members in the camp while some are new-arrivals. Depending on the capacity those who have close family members will be admitted first into the camp.
