Structural Integrity Index Score



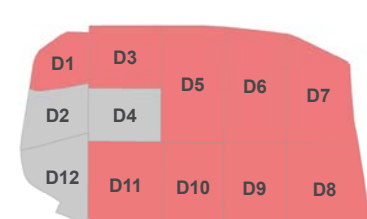
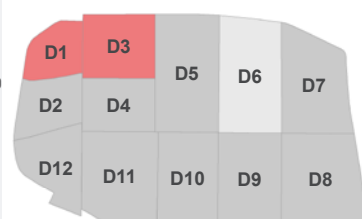
