



## SGBV Field Sub-Working Group – Za’atari Thursday, October 23, 2014 – UNHCR Meeting Room 2 – Meeting Minutes

**Chair:** IRC

**Attendants:** OXFAM, SCI, IRD, NRC, UNHCR, UN-Women, UNICEF.

- **Endorsement of previous meeting minutes:** Meeting minutes were endorsed and action points reviewed. In particular a) GBV-IMS: A first report outlining 6 months GBV-IMS data analysis will be circulated by the national GBV-IMS coordinators. Report data will be used by Za’atari GBV group members to create base-line data and support SGBV interventions. B) Case Management Coordination Meetings: next steps will focus on strengthening referrals for women at risk and bolstering collaboration with community service. Item will be brought to next SGBV meeting.
- **Community gatherings:** Ms. Claire Wilson from the Community Mobilization Working Group (CM-WG) presented the community gathering projected. The project aims to increase two-ways communication between refugee community and aid organizations and strengthen refugees decision-making through district meetings. Pilot project started in districts 3, 7 & 10, targeting men, young men and women and it’s expected to be fully rolled-out by mid-November. Building on the community gathering initiative group members proposed to continue engagement with CMWGs and bring forward discussions on how community gatherings could be used to further integrate SGBV interventions, including district based orientations and other women-based initiatives. Group members also advocated for further inclusion and representation of adolescent girls in community gatherings.
- **Safety audit updates:** First phase of safety audit data collection completed with 250 refugees individually interviewed in all 12 camp-districts. All refugees were randomly selected through UNHCR ProGres and data collected by 27 collectors from different agencies using ICT4P. Preliminary findings are currently under analysis, forming the basis for the roll-out of focus group discussions (FGDs). FGDs are expected to take place in the first week of November. **Action Points:** Monday, October 27, data collectors will meet to brainstorm on key interviews findings and understand areas that need to be further investigated through FGDs. Tuesday, October 28, safety-Audit Task Force member will meet to build on preliminary findings and finalize FGDs, including FGDs focal points and timelines.
- **16 Days of Activism:** 16 Days of Activism will start November 25 and will run until December 11, 2014. Jordan theme will focus on preventing violence and staying safe, responding to survivors of violence and early marriages and will also be used in the Za’atari. Messages will be further integrated using Amani Campaign. **Action Point:** a) Chair to share concept note with Age and Disability task force for their inputs. B) Group members to submit their organization specific activities to the chair no later than Wednesday October 31. C) Chair to compile inputs and share them with national coordinators on Thursday October 31.
- **AOB :** a) Mr. AliShah Tahir joins the group and replaces Ms. Hamida Jahamah as new Za’atari CP SWG chair. B) Monday, November 3 there will be a joint CP/SGBV Za’atari Sub-WG meeting. The meeting will focus on updating each group on ongoing interventions and activities and identify areas in need of strengthening and further collaboration. C) PRT working group will include an orientation on PSEA. Aim is to build knowledge and awareness on PSE for humanitarian workers.
