

MHPSS Working Group Minutes of Meeting
December 17th, 2014 – Ministry of Health, Amman
Chaired by Ahmad Bawaneh (IMC) and Zein Ayoub (WHO)

1. Introduction & Member Updates:

New focal point from World Vision Jordan is attending the MHPSS meetings. No new members.

2. Presentation by Operation Mercy:

Julianne from Operation Mercy provided a presentation on their activities as follows:

- The main areas of operation are informal education, physiotherapy services, psychosocial support and life skills including:
 - Providing informal English education
 - Educational sessions on health/hygiene, child care skills, life skills
 - Recreational activities for children and youth
 - Referral to specialized services
 - Women's groups for mothers
 - Distribution of NFIs (health and hygiene kits)
- Operation Mercy is currently working in Zarqa and Amman, targeting women, girls and boys.

3. Presentation on the Gender-Based Violence Information Management System (GBV-IMS):

Belen from UNHCR delivered a presentation on the gender-based violence information management system. The GBV-IMS is a data management system that enables those providing services to SGBV survivors to effectively and safely collect, store, analyze and share data related to reported incidents of SGBV.

The GBV-IMS standard format was developed by the global Steering Committee. In Jordan, the GBV-IMS module in RIAS was created by UNHCR in June 2013 in consolidation with the taskforce and steering committee. Data collection in Jordan started as of 1 May 2014 in Amman, Mafraq, Irbid, and includes the camps (Zaatari, Azraq, EJC, cyber city, KAP).

4. Updates on the changes in access to governmental health services by Syrian refugees:

As of 20 November, following a decision by the Cabinet, registered Syrian refugees are no longer entitled to access free health services at MOH facilities. Syrian refugees are now charged the same fees as non-insured Jordanians, which is around 35-60% of what Jordanians pay.
