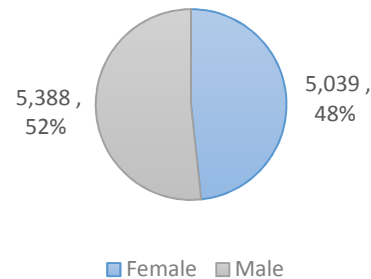
**Cohorts - children sensitized**



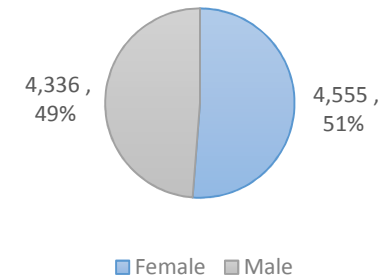

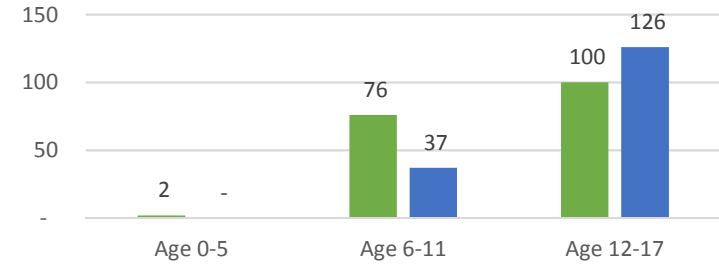

Focused PSS - Sex



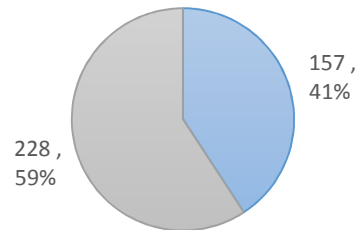

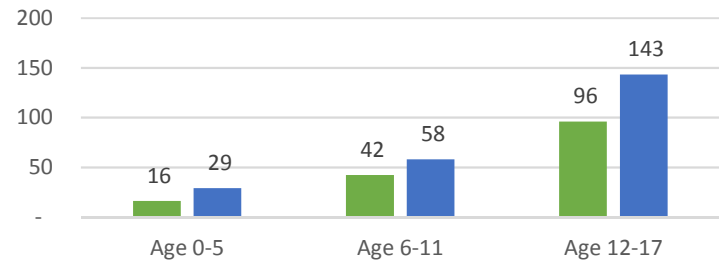
