### **2. Presentation on Washington Model for Disability by MC:**

The International Classification for Functioning (ICF) is a tool which looks at the function and difficulties people with disabilities face (vision issues, hearing aids, mobility, remembering and concentration, communication and daily life skills). The ICF looks at the functions and activities that are affected and the level at which the person participates in this activity by asking a set of question to determine the level of support needed. Details about how these disabilities are evaluated were presented to the group. This is a census tool to help understand the problem this person faces and to properly help the person in need; it is not a tool for diagnosis.
