#### 1. Review previous minutes and action points:

The minutes and action points from previous meeting were agreed upon and endorsed by members present at the meeting.

#### 2. Mid-year review of ESWG work plan

Sector members reviewed the ESWG workplan (document attached). Members were asked to encourage their national partners to attend meetings and share with them discussions of the bi-weekly discussions. Also suggested was that the sector should come up with events/ meetings that will encourage them to participate. Translation should also be explored as an option to attract those who are unable to speak English. There is need for a small advocacy team will develop messages to donors requesting for funds.

#### 3. 3RP mid-year review (targets)

Targets for some indicator are not realistic. The targets should be 100% for children receiving any form of education services both in camp and urban areas. In addition to that, some indicators are not being reported against for example social cohesion, school renovated. We should revise targets that agencies will report against. Omar of UNICEF will send out a template with all indicators to members after the meeting for partners to provide inputs for their respective targets..

#### 4. YTF updates

#### 5. AoB (INEE launch and capacity building, children with autism)

- **INEE launch and capacity building:** INEE will be launched in the first week of July. Printing is already ongoing of the English version of the document while the team is also translating the document into Arabic. By the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of June, all printing will be finalized. There will be 7 trainings conducted in Amman, Mafraq, Irbid, Zarqa, Zaatari and Azraq in both English and Arabic. Agencies who wish to train their own staff will be provided with the INEE document for reference. Tentatively 42 MoE staff will be receive training as agreed with MoE.
- **Children's animation project:** A Jordanian graphics designer and animator, Rakan Al-Hadeed, presented a concept note on children's animation and drawing project. The project will help children to practice creative skills through drawing and animation. He is seeking a partner for implementation of this project. - **Children with autism:** The sector is seeking for agencies which can train members on how to address the needs of children with autism and ensure that they are included in schools.
