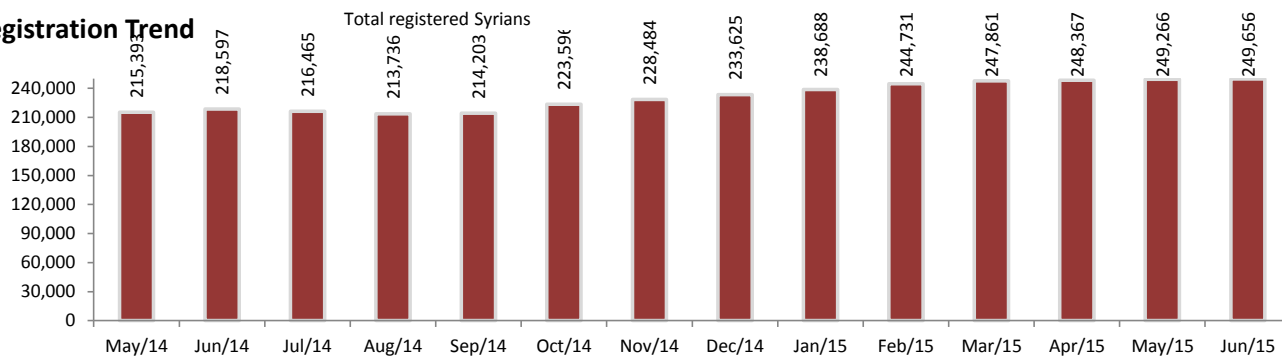

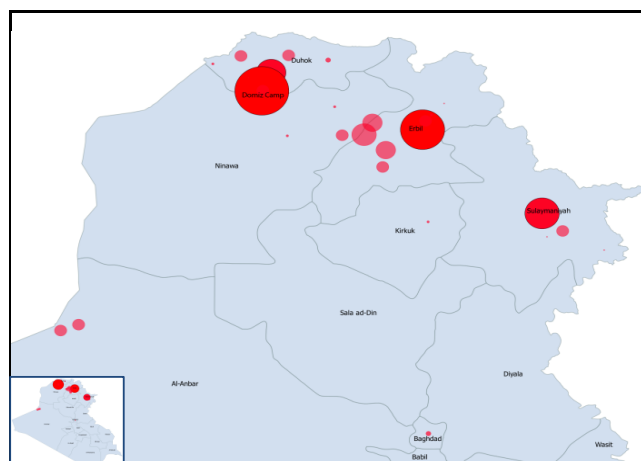

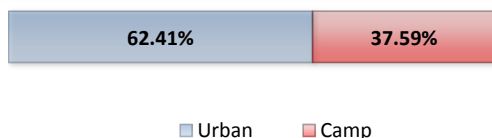
## Age and Gender Breakdown
