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Topics for further discussion:

- How is the reduction of the food vouchers for refugees impacting on other sectors?
- There are currently multiple definitions for the concept of 'Household'. Need for discussion to understand the different definitions.
- How/what is the process to combine survey results? Who is doing this? Some contradiction in surveys is being observed. Those need to be identified and discussed in the IS meetings on how to address those.
