

## CP Field Sub-Working Group Meeting Minutes – Za’atari

Thursday 26th February, 2015, UNHCR Meeting Room # 2

**Chair:** Save the Children International (SCI)

**Attendants:** *ACTED, International Medical Corps (IMC), Save the Children Jordan (SCJ), Relief International (RI), Save the Children International (SCI), International Rescue Committee (IRC) and UNWOMEN*

### The minutes:

- The ToRs of the WG is nearly finalized, organizations are requested to add their comments, in any, not later than next week in order to incorporate all of the comments and approve and disseminate it in the next meeting.
- With regards to the violence at schools, SCJ had meeting with UNICEF, the same procedures will be applied, such as referring the victims of violence children, to SCJ social workers and SCJ will further refer to Ministry of Education. This issue is prevalent at over populate schools, which is expected to be solved once the Kuwaiti school is open.
- UNICEF conducted training named (CADER) to school teacher, which aims at reducing violence at schools.
- The CP SWG members expressed their views about the merging of CP and GBV working groups, as the membership of both the groups is almost the same. The matter will be discussed with GBV working group (Za’atari).
- Attendances of children at schools were decreased during the last few days due to the weather conditions especially at primary schools.
- IRC is planning 2-days training on un accompanied and separated children, one each day for volunteers and organization’s staff respectively. Organizations are encouraged to send one or two staff who are mainly working on child protection, the training will be held in Za’atari camp.
- UNWOMEN opened their oasis in District 4, and offer comprehensive day care services, open for children of women who are attending and engaged in activities in the two centres. Through this day care, children are provided with a safe space where they can receive

recreational and psychosocial activities. The space is also open for school children, who wish, after school's hours, to spend some time in recreational activities.

- IMC trained 42 Syrian community mobilizers on Psychological First Aid (PFA), the training was conducted on two phases the training is open for all the organizations. Each session could have 20 participants, IMC will send the invitation for the training in the first week of April 2015.
- Tahir, the CP SWG (Za'atari) Coordinator will leave the chair at the end of March, and his colleague Hadeel will take over from him.

### **Action Points**

- CP SWG (Za'atari) Coordinator will discuss with the GBV working group, the merging of CP & GBV working groups.
- IRC to send the invitation for the upcoming "Un accompanied & separated children" training at Za'atari camp.
- IRC will be updating the CP SWG (Za'atari) about their activities around child protection in Za'atari Camp.
- UNWOMEN to meet with "Save the Children Jordan" in district 4 to discuss areas of possible collaboration between the two organizations
