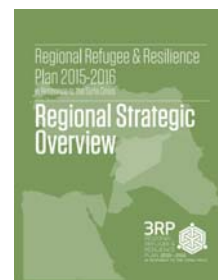
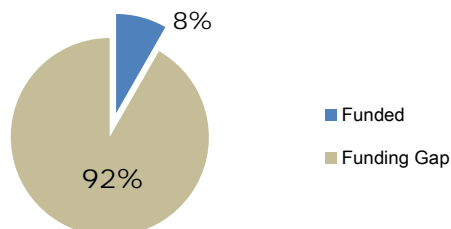


## 3RP REGIONAL REFUGEE AND RESILIENCE PLAN - 2015
