Tsunami: 4 female for every 1 male death

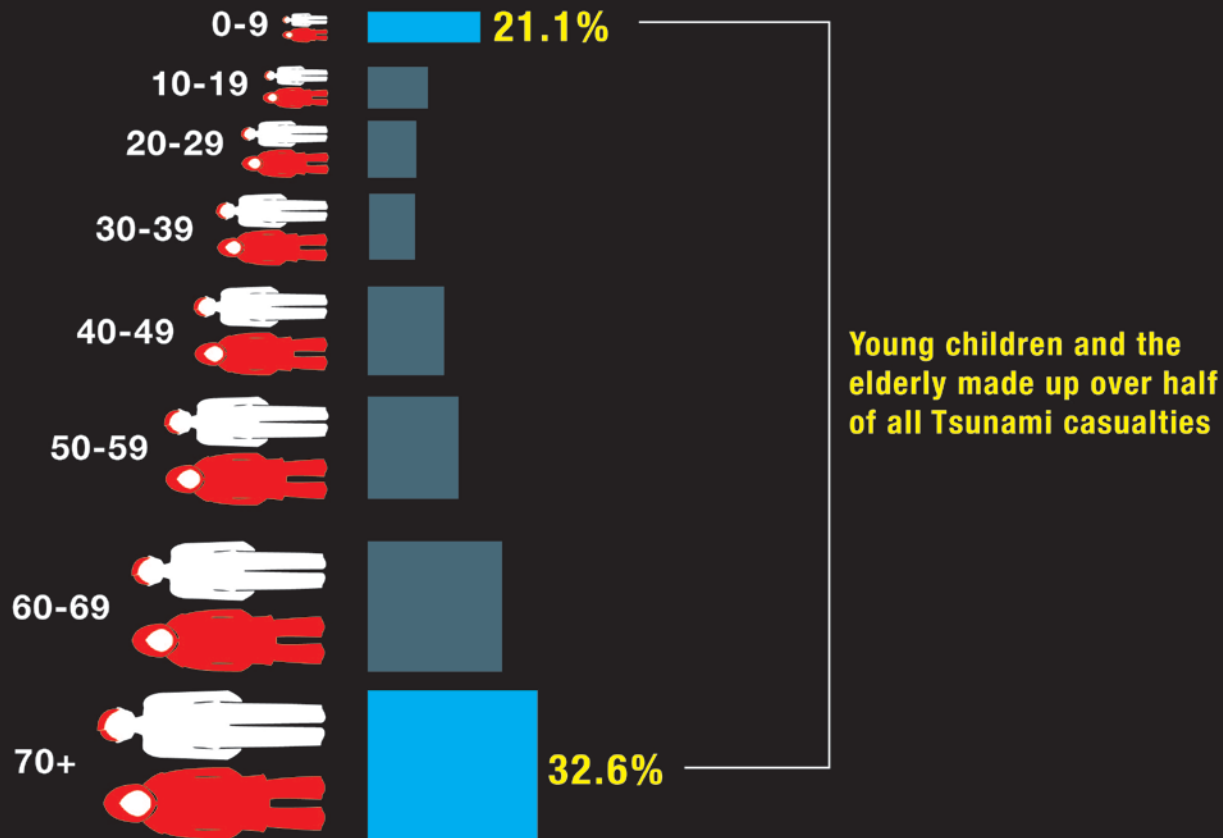


Direct War Deaths 1990s



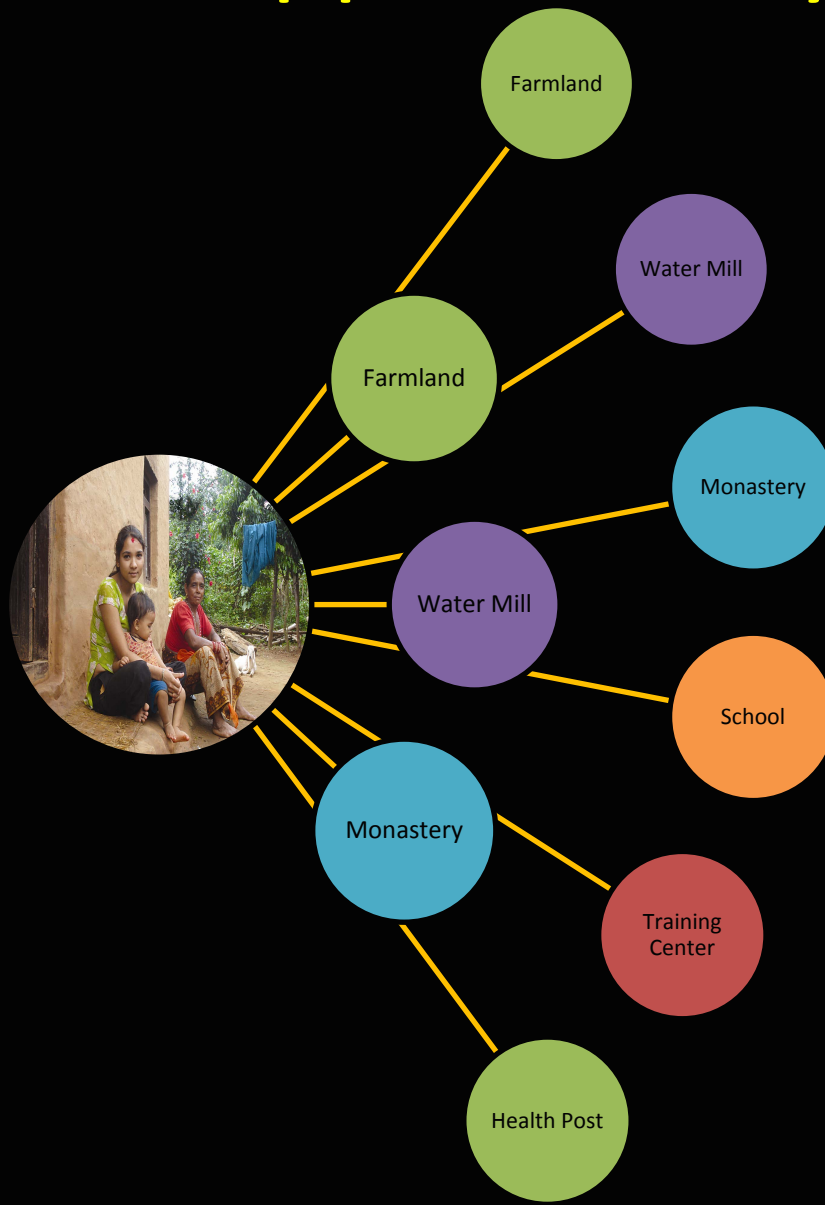

Survey of Extremely Vulnerable Populations in IDP Camps, Uganda



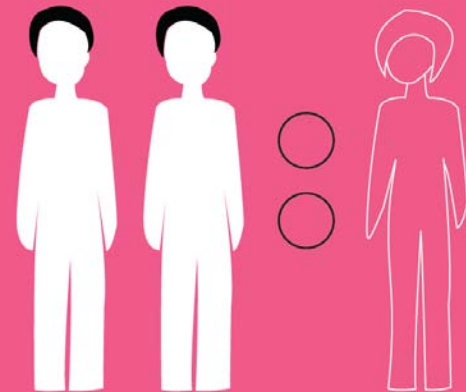
8 in 10 of the “extremely vulnerable populations” who did not return home were over 60 years old

Getting it right



- Women collect water
- Women prepare food
- Most victims will be women
- Target education at women

Cholera Deaths by Sex in Haiti (87 cases)



2 out of 3 dead due to cholera were male



Reality check

1. **Collecting & using data is good! But**
2. Virtually no collection in Phase I & II
3. Education & Shelter do better
4. When collected, little used
5. **Where used, demonstrable difference**





Why?

- Evidence doesn't matter
- Donors and cluster leaders not interested
- Collecting evidence makes us accountable
- Don't believe it is possible
