When you arrive at the Piraeus Port

Go to the Building in front of GATE E1 where you can have access to shower, WC and clothes and get more information about other services.

NOTE: Free WiFi in all areas of Piraeus Port.

TRANSPORTATION IN ATHENS

- Bus from Port to Metro:

Bus in Port is FREE. Take the free bus, from the official bus stops only. It will take you to the exit next to the metro station "Piraeus" (Gate E7).

- Metro:

€ 1,40 - Includes all city metro lines, trams, and city buses (except express buses) for 90 min.

€ 0,60 - Reduced ticket for all means of transport for children and elderly over the age of 65.

€ 4,50 - Includes all city metro lines, trams, and city buses (except express buses) for 24 hours.

What to expect – Practical Information



-Eleonas District Camp, Agiou Polikarpou 87, Athens, Greece 118 55

Transportation: Take the metro from Piraeus to Monastiraki Station (7 stops) and transfer to the Number 3, Blue Line. Go two stops to Eleonas Station. Services: WiFi and charging stations, Hot showers, Play area for children, Information about Voluntary Repatriation by International Organization for Migration (IOM).

-Elliniko District Camp, Olympic Stadium, Agiou Gerasimou Str., Elliniko 167 77

Transportation: Take the metro from Piraeus to Falirou. Then take the tram Peace and Friendship Stadium towards Voula and get off at Loutra Alimou (16 stops) and walk 10 min till the Hockey Centre. Services: Food, Health Services, Non-food items.

-Schisto Relocation Camp, Military Camp "Stefanakis", Perama 188 63

Transportation: Take the Bus 871 from Piraeus metro station towards Elefsina (via Ethniki Antistaseos Avenue) and get off at 4th Schistou stop (24 stops) and walk 3 min till Schisto Camp. Services: Food, Health Services, Non-food items, Shower.

ATTENTION! MIGRANTS WHO DO NOT APPLY FOR ASYLUM OR DO NOT RETURN HOME VOLUNTARILY WITHIN 30 DAYS WILL BE DEPORTED FROM GREECE!

- If you are fleeing war, persecution, torture, or inhumane and degrading treatment YOU CAN APPLY FOR ASYLUM. Only then you will have the right to stay, to have access to health care and to school.
- If you have close family members living in another European country, it may be possible to reunite with them through the asylum procedure.
- **IF YOU ARE CITIZENS of Syria, Eritrea, the Central African Republic, Iraq, Yemen, Bahrain and Swaziland**, as well as stateless persons who were residing in these countries, **AND HAVE APPLIED FOR ASYLUM IN GREECE THEN YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR A RELOCATION SCHEME**. During the time you wait to be relocated, you will be provided accommodation and humanitarian support.

HOW TO REQUEST ASYLUM IN GREECE

Register your application at the Regional Asylum Office of Attica.

Procedure: You will have to hand in your travel documents (passport) or any other document relevant to the examination of your application, (verification of your family members' identity and yours, your country of origin and your family status). For more Information, please ask help from the Greek Authorities or a representative of UNHCR.

HOW TO APPLY FOR RELOCATION

HOW TO APPLY FOR VOLUNTARY REPATRIATION

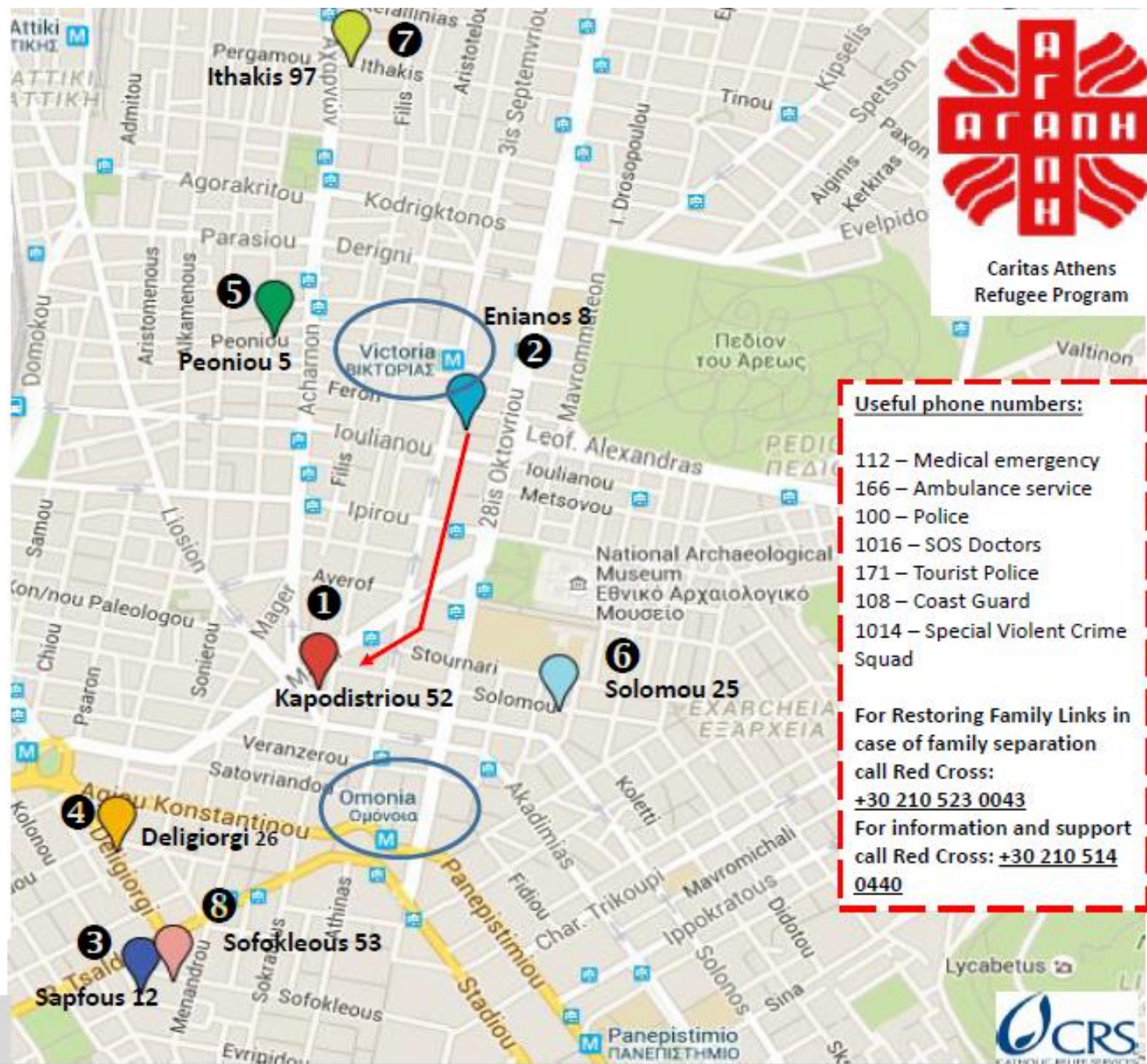
