

# North East Nigeria Crisis: Humanitarian Snapshot (as of 30 January 2015)

The security situation in northeast Nigeria remains volatile impacting on access to population caught in the conflict between insurgents and the government forces.



Boko Haram has been involved in 18% of violent conflicts events in Nigeria since 2009; and 34% of all the fatalities. Boko Haram activity has been concentrated in Borno (59% of events located) followed by Yobe (10%) and Adamawa (5%). At least 9,300 people have been killed since 2009; 2,300 reported killed this year.
