

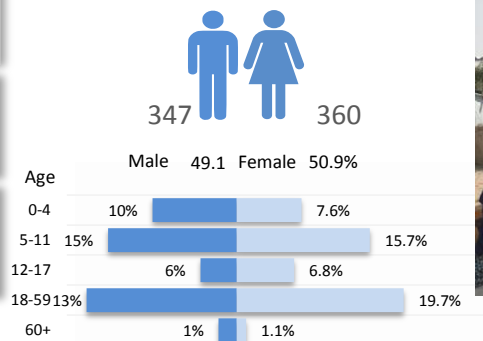

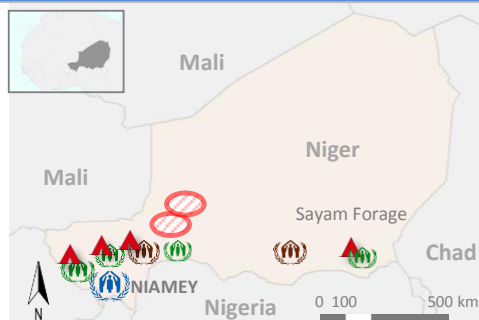

### Context

#### History

Since May 2013, Southeastern Niger (Diffa region) has witnessed an influx of tens of thousands displaced persons from Northern Nigeria following the declaration of the state of emergency in Borno, Yobe and Adamawa States in Nigeria on 14 May 2013. The displaced population is seeking shelter in the families and villages of Niger. In December 2014, due to the violent attacks by insurgents in Bosso and the lake Chad region, the increased influx gave precedence to construct the SAYAM forage camp. The camp has a capacity to host 10,000 people extendable to 20,000. Nevertheless, UNHCR ensures that transfer to the camp is made on a voluntary basis

Incidence of sexual violence

#### Health



Limited evacuation capacity. The main hospital, located in Diffa is 45 km away from the camp

A new ambulance is handed over to the camp health center by UNHCR in order to reinforce the referral system. A general vaccination campaign (including against measles) was conducted among children

#### Wash



Limited access to potable water

Water tracking is in progress. Water pipeline construction and borehole rehabilitation are launched.

#### Shelter



Infrastructure for basic services and coordination

Transit centre for the new arrival and screening purposes, security and medical screening hangars, hangars for registration, Coordination (partners), health care facilities, community centres and distribution centre.
