

WORKING WITH PARTNERS

ogether with the DRC Government authorities, in particular the National Commission for Refugees (CNR), UNHCR nanages and provides humanitarian assistance and protection to refugees, returnees and internally displaced persons. Within the collaborative IDP cluster approach, support is delivered jointly with MONUC, WFP, UNICEF, OCHA, UNDP, UNFPA, WHO, and FAO, among other agencies and NGOs. UNHCR leads the Protection cluster and with UNDP co-leads the eintegration and Community Recovery cluster. UNHCR is also lead of the Protection and Prevention component of the Comprehensive Strategy to Combating SGBV in DRC. In the field, assistance is delivered together with 30 implementing partners: ACF, ADRA, ADSSE, AIDES, AIRD, ARAL, CAMPS, CARITAS, CDI BWAMANDA, CIP, CNR, ERUKIN, FEMISA, GRACE, HOPE, IEADA, INTERSOS, AIGLONS, LWF, MAAS, MEDAIR, OIM, OXFAM, PLD, PU, SAVE THE CHILDREN,, SFCG,
