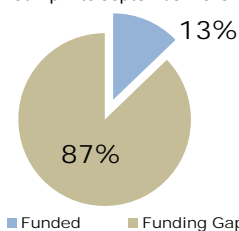


# 2015 BURUNDI REGIONAL REFUGEE RESPONSE PLAN
