



NIGERIA: UNHCR INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT RESPONSE ACTIVITIES AS OF SEP 2015

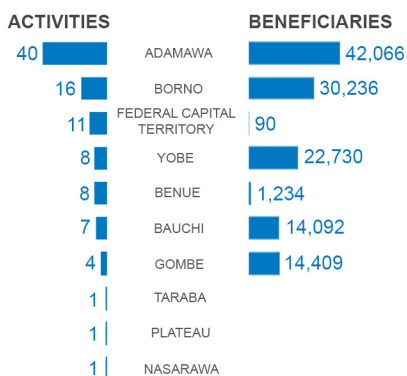
The pillars of UNHCR IDP operational engagement will focus on coordination of protection activities at the national and State level; co-ordination of shelter and NFI/CCCM strategy at national and State levels, as well as relevant support, based on effective vulnerability screening; capacity building, supporting the development of effective protection framework and implementing specific and targeted protection services for the most vulnerable IDPs. UNHCR's role on CCCM and Shelter and NFIs activities will focus on provision of assistance to the most vulnerable families in the three existing types of settlements and co-leadership role along with NEMA and IOM. UNHCR's IDP activities will focus on States in the North East which are particularly affected by the conflict whereas the agency will also carry out targeted activities in the Federal Capital Territory and North Central region.



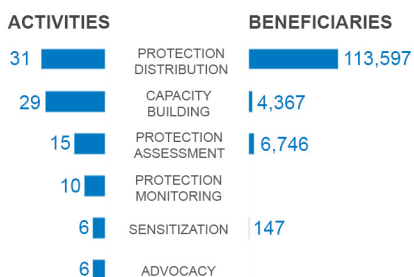
