



INARA'S COVERAGE CRITERIA

INARA works with children from conflict areas who have sustained catastrophic injury or illness, connecting them to life saving or life altering medical treatment. Through this provision, INARA aims to reverse the physical disability caused by injury or to ensure the child has access to the appropriate treatment for chronic illness.

Once a potential beneficiary is referred to INARA:

- The beneficiary will be assessed by INARA's team in order to determine whether the case falls within the coverage criteria (we will consider cases which have had prior treatment)
- There may be times when INARA does not have capacity take on all cases which fit under the coverage criteria at the time of referral
- If the case is accepted, INARA will ensure the beneficiary receives the appropriate treatment either by covering the cost or partnering with a relevant humanitarian organisation

The following beneficiaries are included in INARA's coverage criteria:

1. Beneficiary group <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Registered and unregistered Syrian refugeesb. Registered and unregistered Palestine refugees from Syriac. Ages 0 – 18 (inclusive)d. Based in Beirut or can travel to Beirut (all medical treatment to be provided in Beirut unless assessed otherwise)
2. Life saving/ Life altering <p>All injuries must be assessed against the criteria of 'life saving' and/ or 'life altering' medical treatment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Life saving:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Possibility of death unless surgically reversedb. Life altering:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Injury that is causing a severe reversible physical disability
3. INARA will pay for <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Medical testing: only when the possible diagnosis falls within the realm of our services (3.b – d)b. Orthopedic surgery (including orthopedic implants)c. Injury requiring reconstructive and plastic surgery, including bone and soft tissue injuriesd. Burn scars causing reversible physical disability and which require surgical treatmente. Dental implants, only as part of craniofacial reconstructive surgery (3.c)f. Medication, only if related to the injury or illness and only up to the age of 18. Medication provided after 18 will be up to INARA's discretiong. Logistical costs relating to the medical treatment e.g. transportation
4. Other urgent cases will be assessed on a case-by-case basis
