

Shelter + NFI Sector WG – Samos 07.07.2016

Present: Save the Children, Praksis, Hellenic Red Cross, BRF, Samos Volunteers (SV), UNHCR, Arsis, MSF, European Commission

1. Shelter:

Arsis:

- 8 persons in the accommodation
- waiting for 2 more flats that will bring the capacity up to 20-22 beds
- difficulties with renting new apartments as many locals don't want to rent their apartments legally or to refugees

MSF:

- looking to rent places in Vathy to increase the capacity of accommodating vulnerable persons. 85 persons are living in two different hotels and there are 8 more vulnerable families in the hotspot to be taken out. The capacity accommodating people can be expanded depending on the needs (vulnerable cases identified in the hotspot)

Praksis:

- the capacity of the shelter is 16 beds. Right now there are 14 persons living there but it is not possible to bring more people

Praksis (unaccompanied minors shelter):

- 25 places, all covered. In the next month 6 positions will be available since some minors will be moving to different countries with the reunification programme (4 to Luxemburg, 1 to Switzerland) or family reunification (1 to Germany)

Tents available: MSF – 200, SV – 32, Dr Manos - expecting tents (quantity not available)

Issue raised by BRF – there are people leaving to Athens without any arranged accommodation. Since they have been living in containers/cabins in the hotspot, they don't have tents to bring with them. The solution is to give tents to persons in this situation.

2. NFIs:

A Google doc with available stock is created. All stock should be updated bi-weekly

UNHCR propose to have a distribution schedule for distribution (other than regular ones)

EC raises concerns about the electrical plates distributed in the camp by Friendly Humans as the electric grid might not be able to support so much consumption.

BRF gaps in the stock – diapers, baby powder, baby shampoo

SV gaps in the stock:

Women:

- underwear s/m
- bras s/m

Men:

- shorts
- t-shirts s/m
- jeans/pants s/m
- caps

Hygiene products:

- soap bars
- wipes
- towels
- washing powder

UNHCR propose to discuss about having a standardised kit for the preparedness plan. So far MSF and SV have their own kits.
