Shade installation	1.1 Still pending 1.2 Navy medical staff operate in RIC. They are attending RIC daily and provide medical assessment and refer to the hospital or to WAHA accordingly. PRAKSIS is ready to provide equipment and more medicines as soon as the container gets repaired. 1.3 WAHA has no budget available for medicine purchase. Waiting for renewal. Medicines that cannot be provided by WAHA stock have been purchased by LSN during the last two days. PRAKSIS deliver medicine to the RIC, get the daily list of medicine and the list of appointments with the hospital and PRAKSIS nurses arrange them. 1.4. SP have been granted access to install them. 1.5 170 A/Cs to be installed in containers of shelter area by RIS 1.6. Will be implemented as soon as the division of the camp takes place.

PoCs, however, refused to drink it yesterday and even refused to eat dinner. They were eventually persuaded to have dinner.</p> <p>1.8 WAHA doctor highlighted that even if the vaccines are received soon, children would have to be vaccinated around 40 days after the chicken pox outbreak.</p> <p>1.9 PRAKSIS is going to receive some medicine in a couple of days. Safe place to keep them has to be found.</p> <p>Chicken pox case at PIKPA too.</p> <p>Broken pipes in shelter area. Black water surfaces were noticed. Damaged pumps because of things thrown in toilets. Overflow of sewage water is going to be disinfected. Contractor is working on repairing damages. Hygiene promotion by SP is going to take place.</p>
