Agenda Item 2: Update

UNHCR updated the group on the progression of the pre-registration exercise, list of camps to be closed /remain long term with site management focal points will be released by GoG at the end of July.

Agenda Item 3: Immunization activities progress

IFRC and HRC updated on the progression of MMR vaccination in different sites. Generally speaking the collaboration and coordination with MoH Public Health has been very close and the exercise is running smoothly. UNICEF has already receive the request for MMR, BCG and DTP.

After 3 cases of Hep A were detected in Ritsona, IFRC is carrying out ring vaccination in the site. Hygiene promotion sessions will follow and will ideally be organized in all sites.

Agenda Item 4: Mental Health

IMC presented the MHPSS assessment. It will be shared with all group members. IMC is scaling up its MH intervention and as part of then a referral network workshop will be organized on Friday 22nd of July with all actors involved in the provision of MH at the sites. The coordination modalities for the MH actors were discussed.
