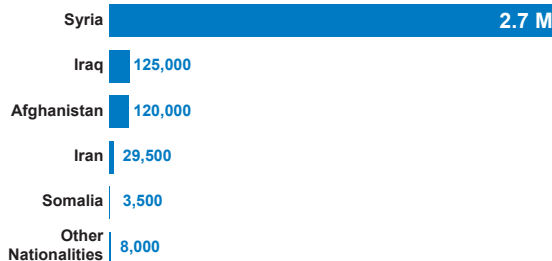

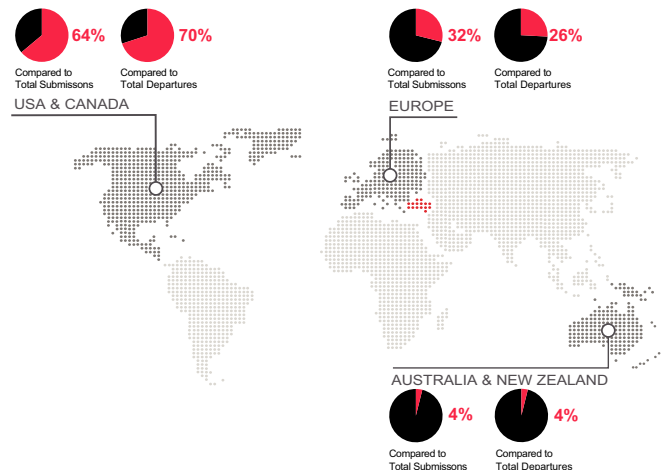
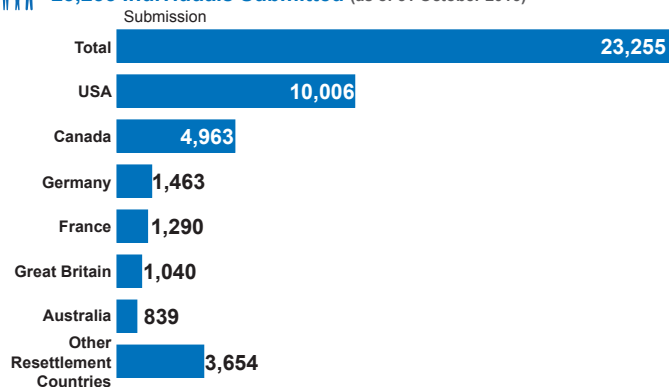
2016 Registration Statistics

**285,000 Individuals Registered with UNHCR** (as of 31 October 2016)



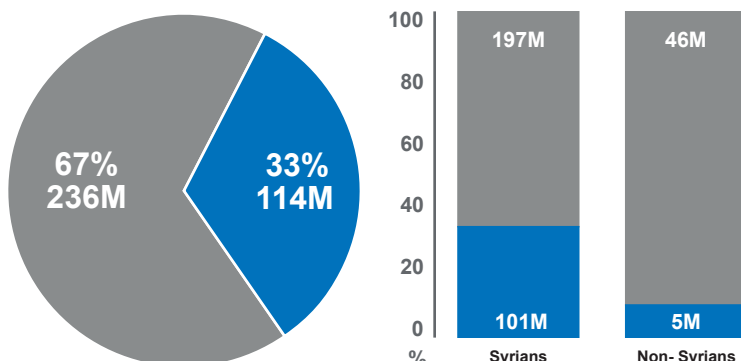
2016 Resettlement Statistics

**23,255 Individuals Submitted** (as of 31 October 2016)



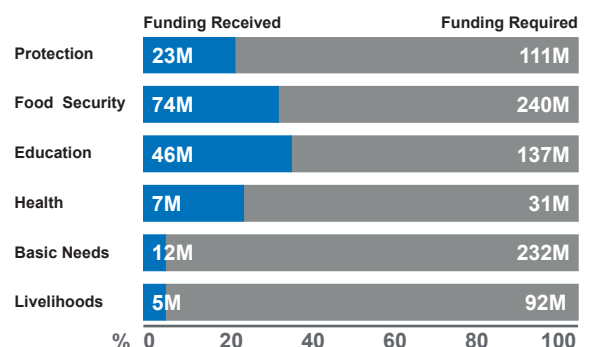
2016 UNHCR Funding Requirement

## Education

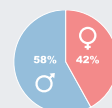
