






# OF BENEFICIARIES BY AGE AND GENDER





# OF BENEFICIARIES BY TYPE




## PROTECTION

PEOPLE REACHED **686,677**

### CURRENT SITUATION

686,677 reached, including 261,925 vulnerable individuals profiled/monitored/registered, 54,633 vulnerable individuals provided with targeted protection-based material assistance; 213,640 reached with community-based sensitizations; 86,637 individuals reached with psychosocial support; 47,948 individuals referred to appropriate specialized services; and capacity of 14,621 individuals built through trainings including 420 peace-building, 5,999 of vulnerable persons have been reached through specific protection services (Legal Aid, HLP Support, Livelihood, Detention Visits).




## CHILD PROTECTION

PEOPLE REACHED **285,174**

### CURRENT SITUATION

285,174 children reached, including 256,684 provided with psychosocial support through child friendly spaces/child clubs; 4,651 UASC (including 328 UASC reunified and 701 unaccompanied identified); 1,739 UASC placed in alternative care arrangements and benefited from follow-up; 5,420 children at risk and survivors supported through inter-agency case management system, and 10,988 children benefiting from mine risk education.




## SGBV SEXUAL AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

PEOPLE REACHED **435,812**


### CURRENT SITUATION

435,812 reached, including 248,926 vulnerable persons provided with psychosocial counseling support; 149,766 individuals reached through sensitizations on SGBV and SEA; 24,662 women and girls received dignity kits; 4,972 trained on SGBV interventions; and 6,240 vulnerable women and girls gained skills for livelihoods.






