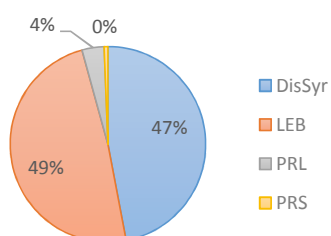

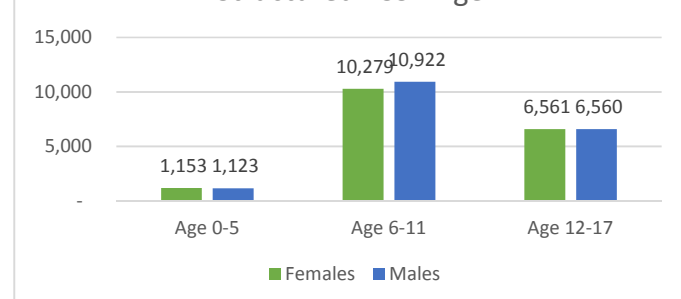

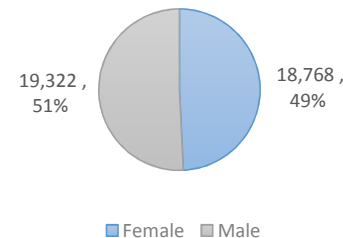

Sex - children sensitized



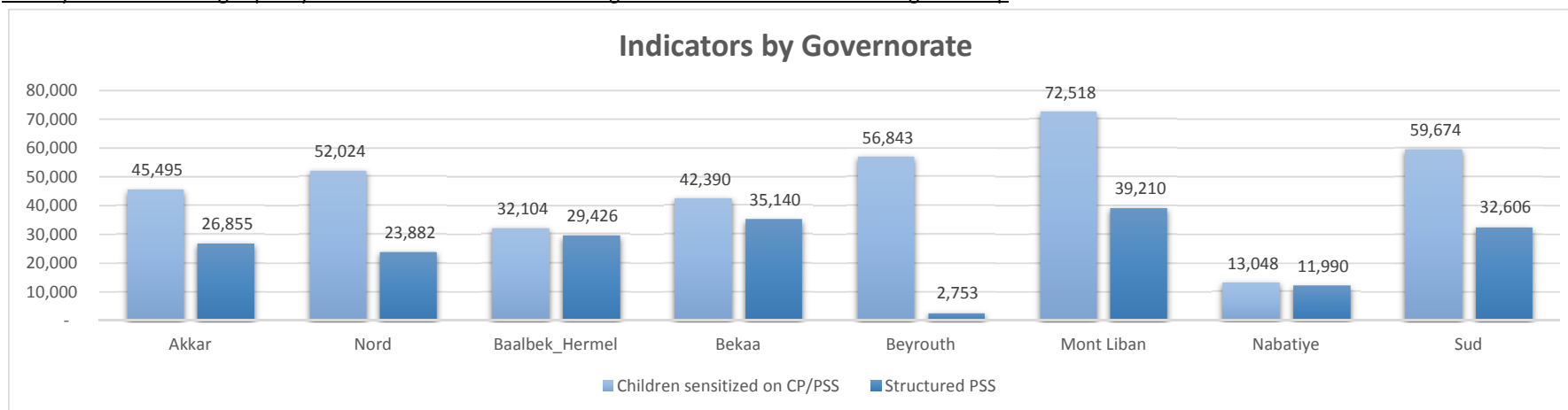

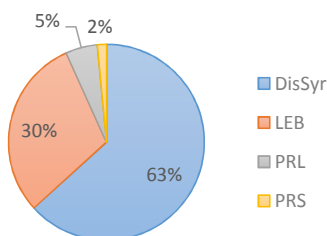

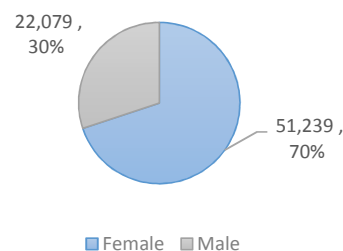

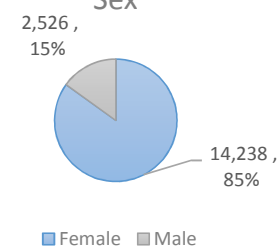
Caregivers sensitized - Cohorts



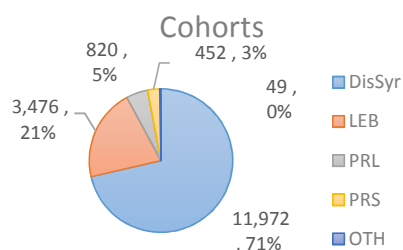
Caregivers sensitized - Sex



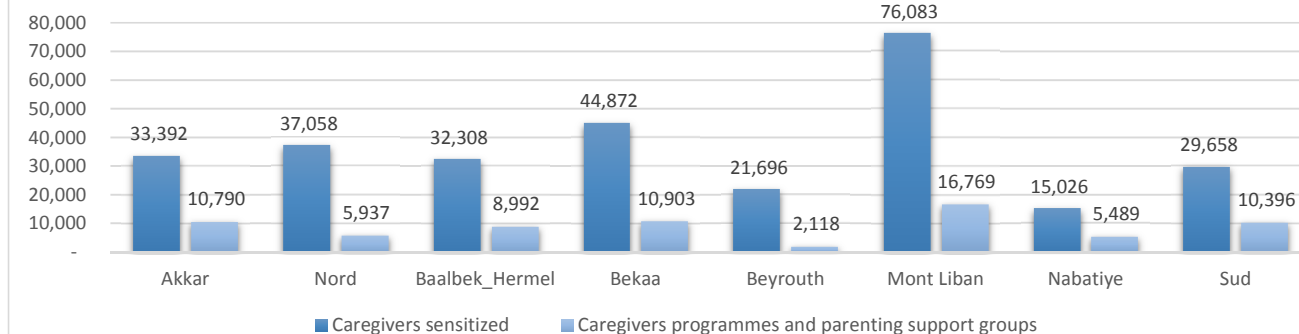

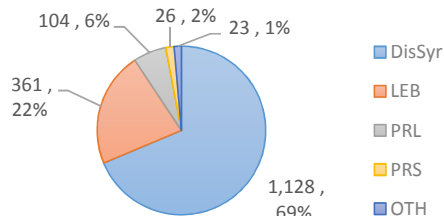

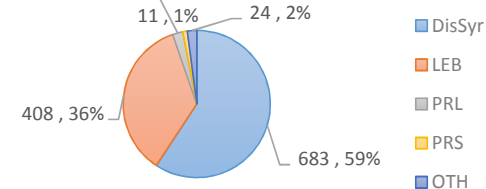
Focused PSS - Cohorts



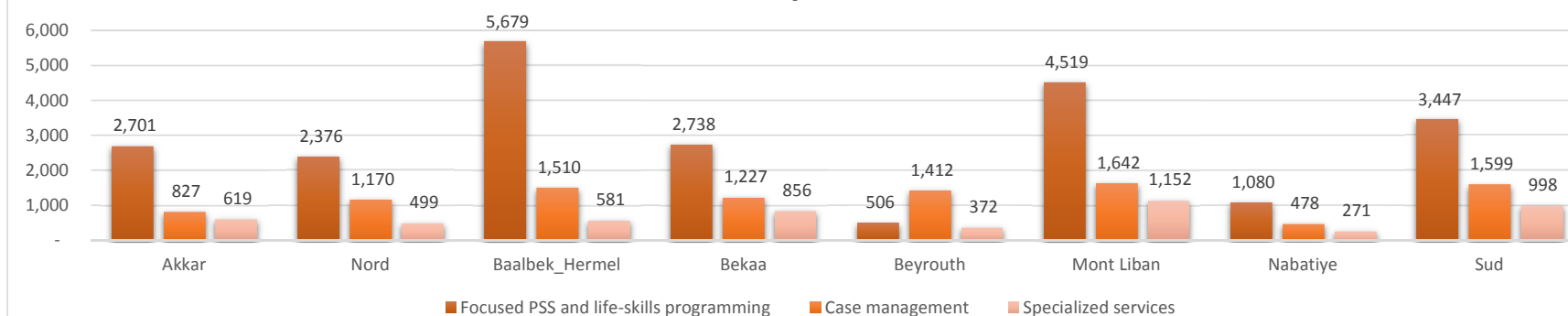

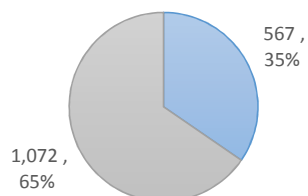

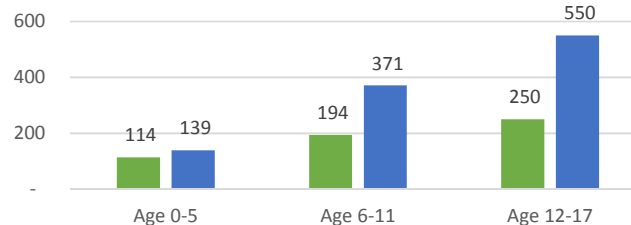
Focused PSS - Age



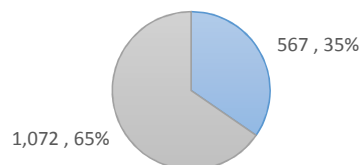
Case Management - Sex



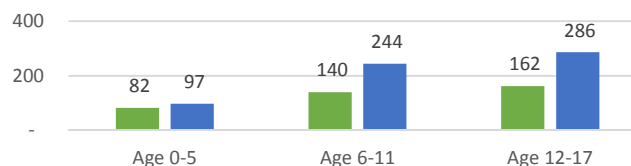
