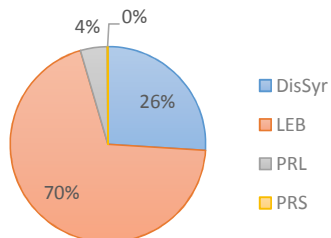

Cohorts - children sensitized

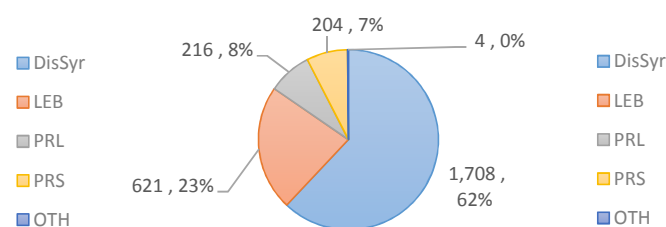

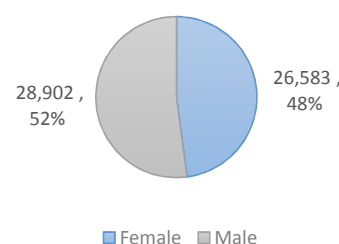

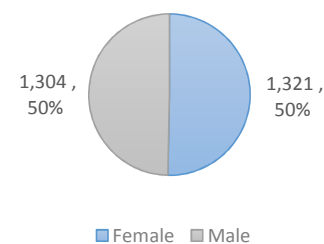
Structured PSS - Age

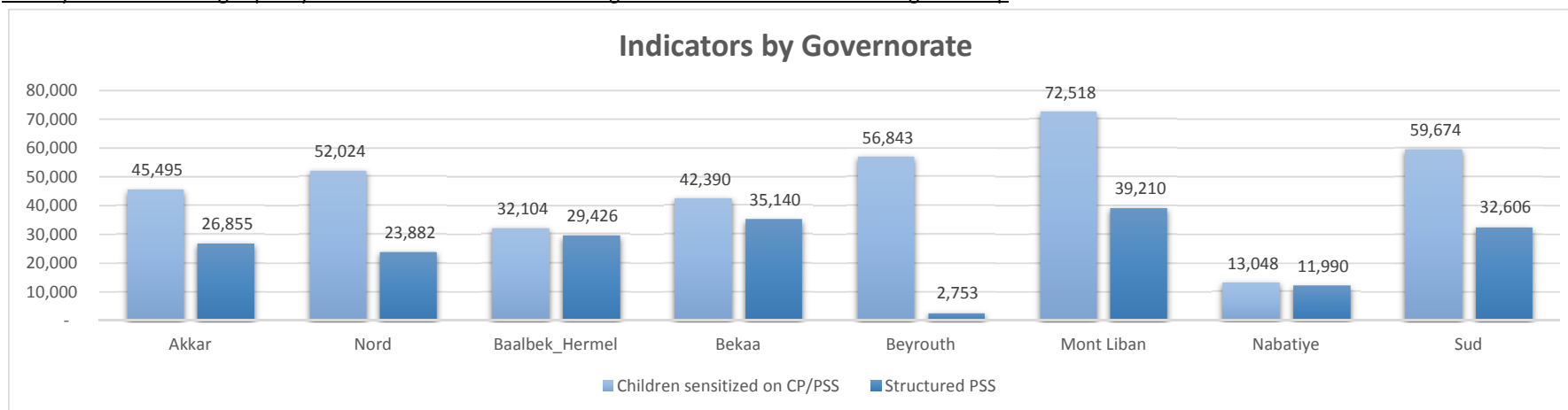

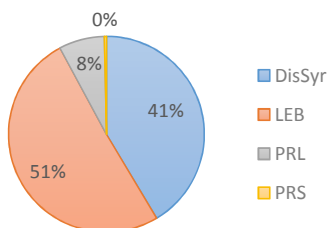

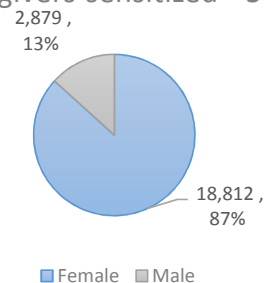

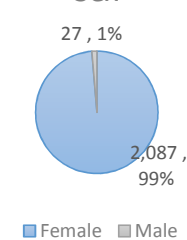
Caregivers sensitized - Cohorts



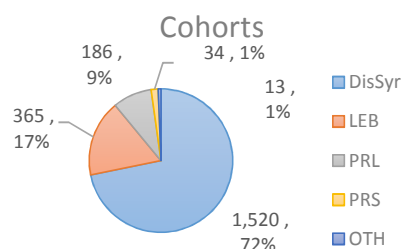
Caregivers sensitized - Sex



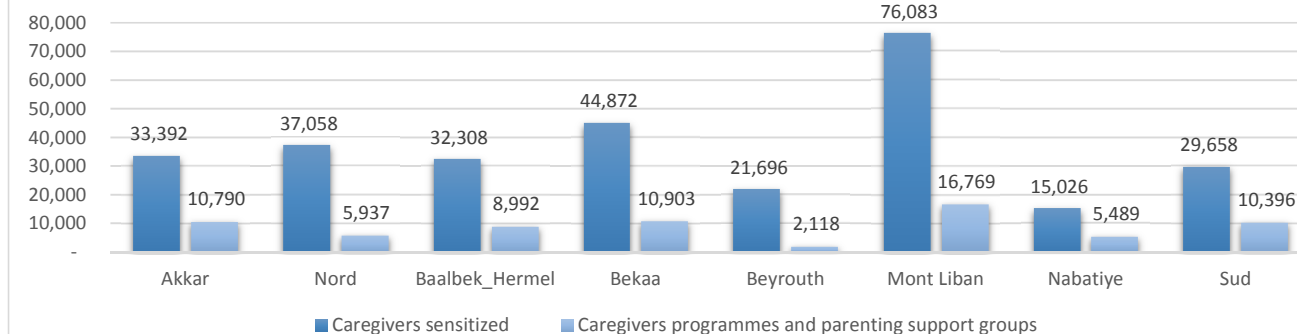

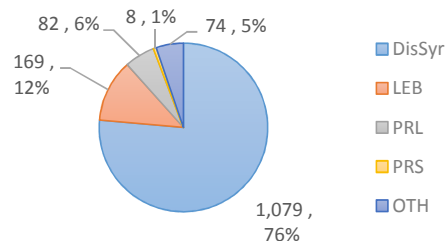

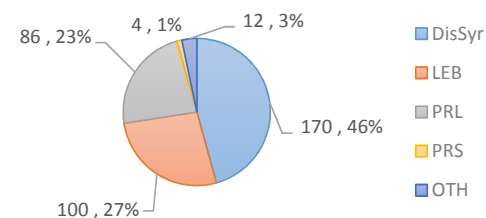
Focused PSS - Cohorts



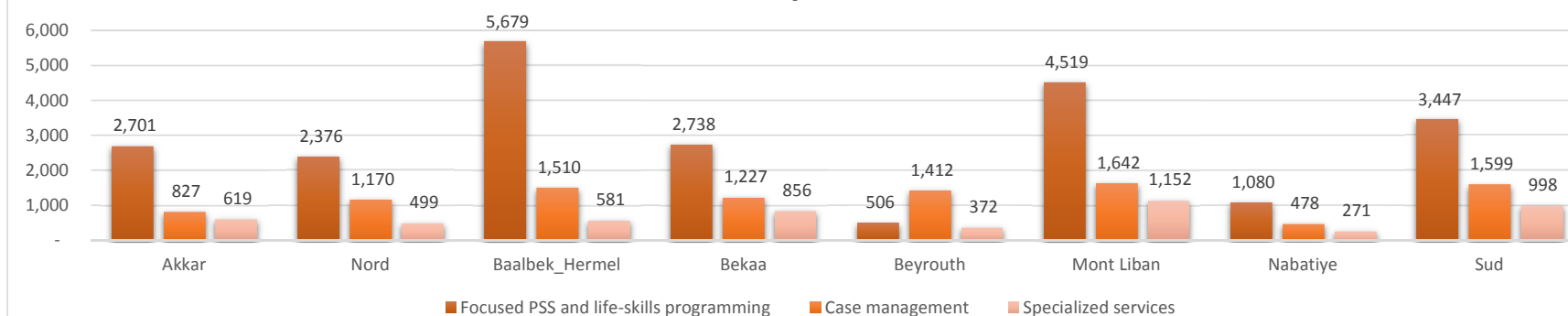
Case Management - Cohorts

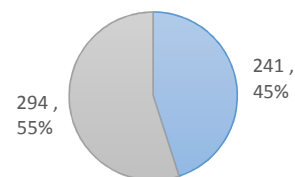

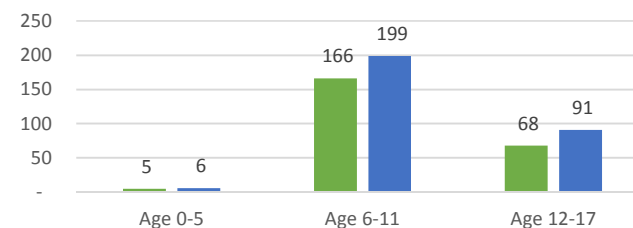

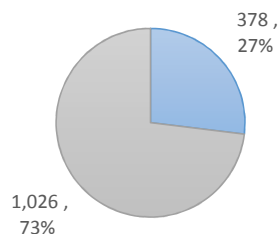
Focused PSS - Age



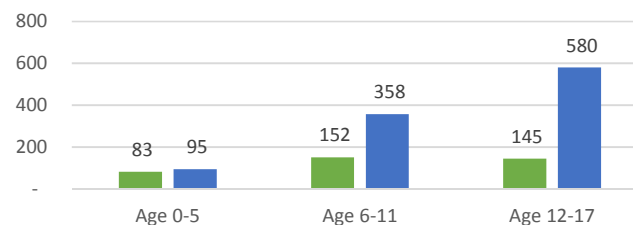

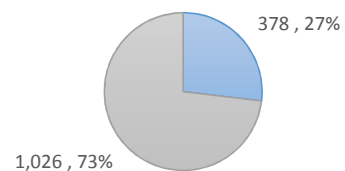

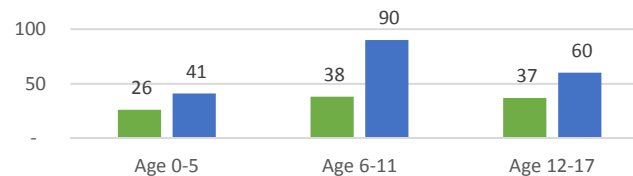

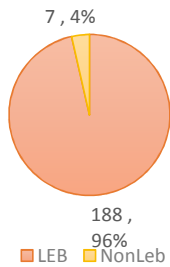
