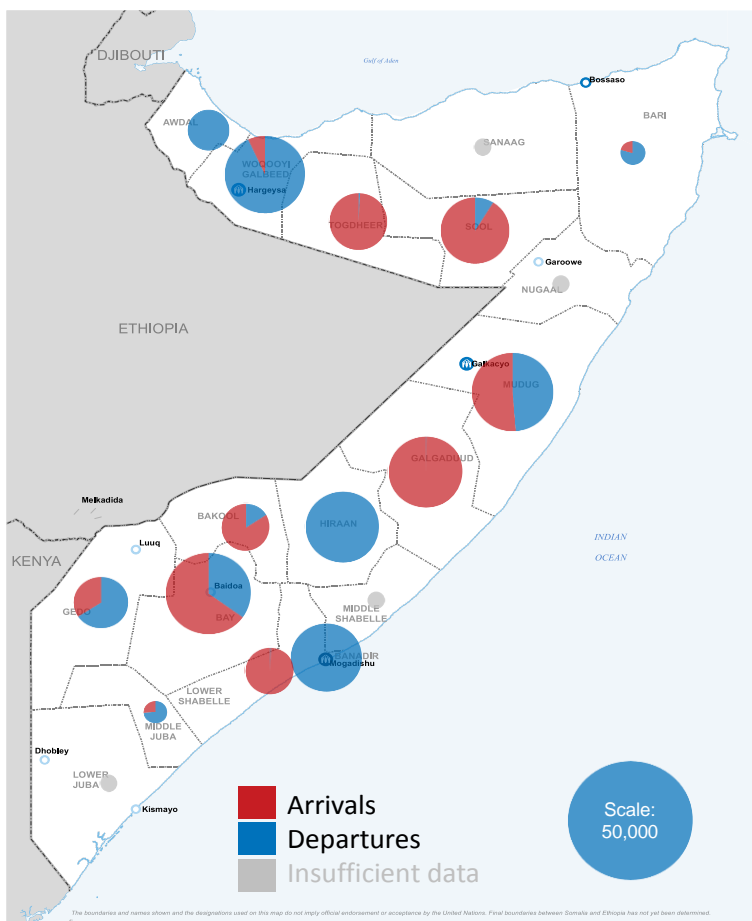

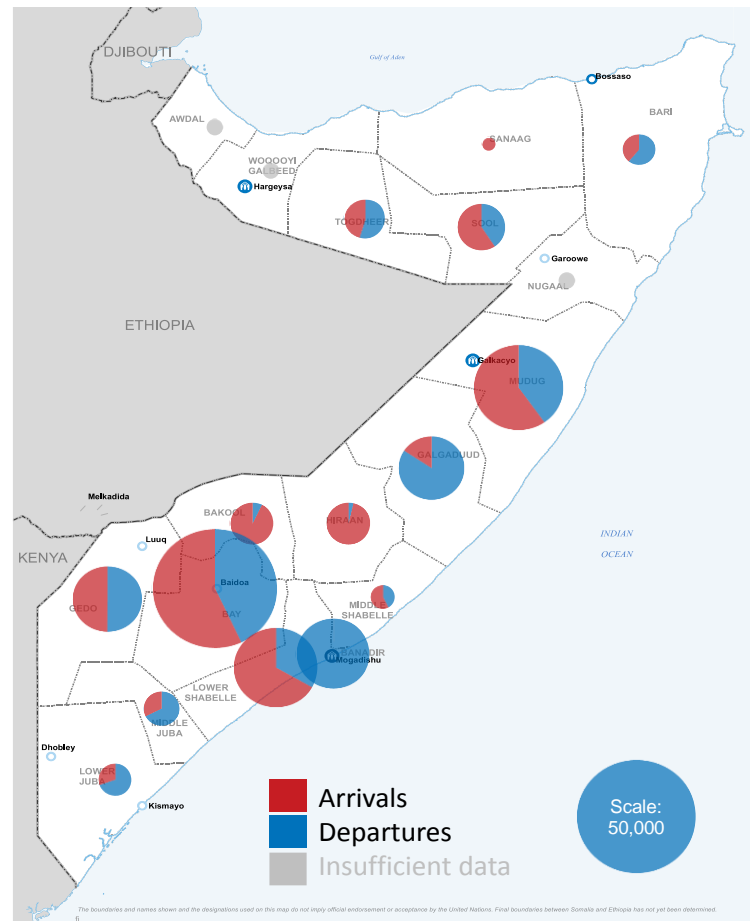

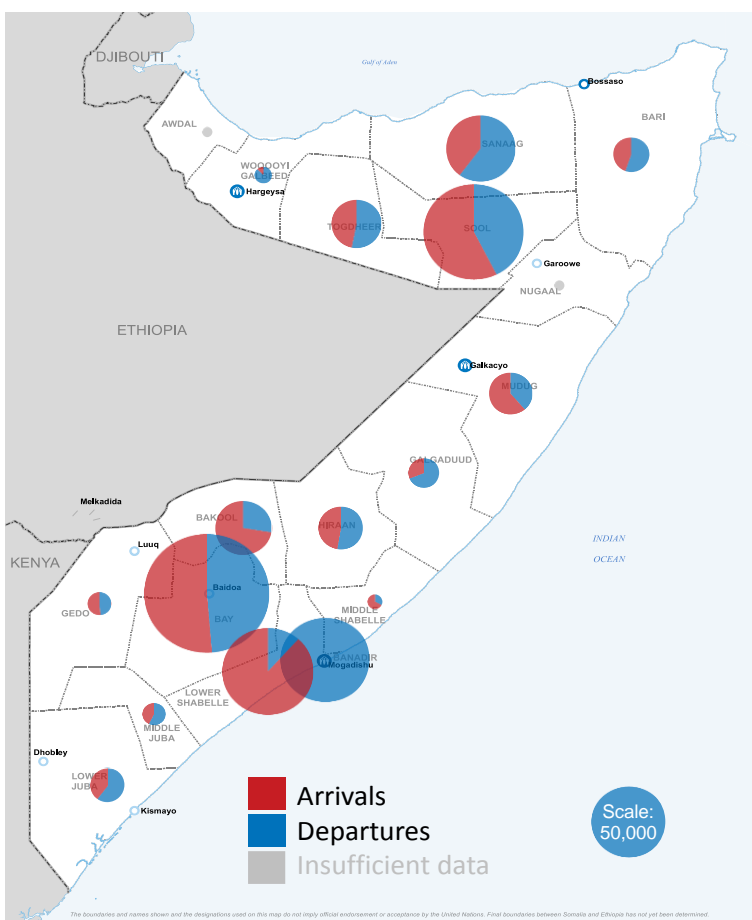
Drought-driven displacements by REGION monitored by PRMN in period:  
**1 Nov 2016 - 31 Jan 2017**



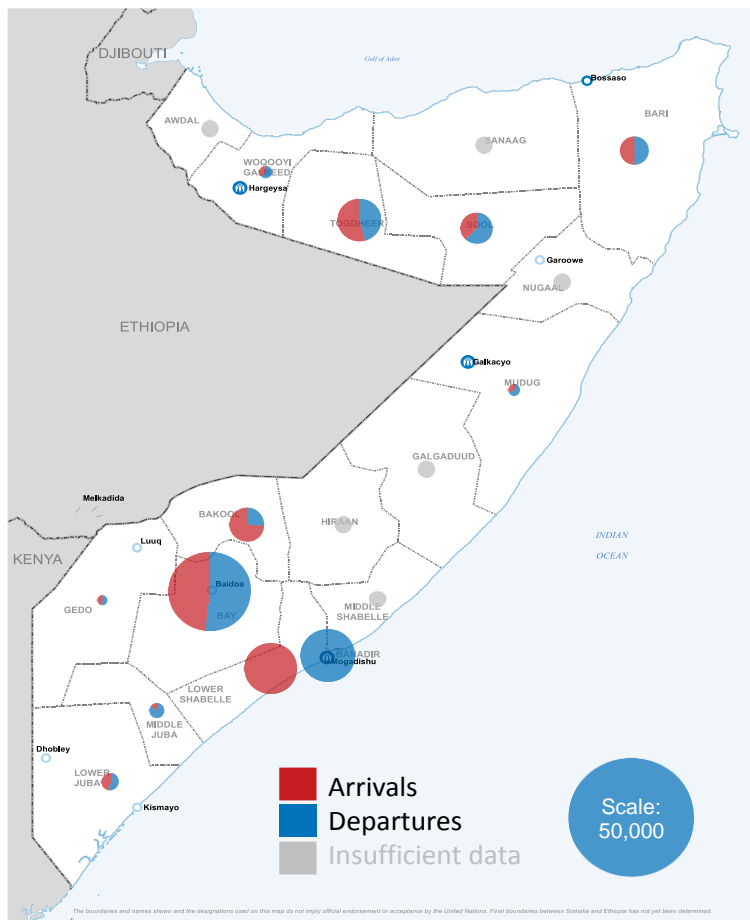
Drought-driven displacements by REGION monitored by PRMN in period:


