




In March 2017, 3RP partners involved in 3RP response in Egypt have provided 10,956 curative and preventive Primary Healthcare consultations to Syrian girls, boys, women and men. Among those, 5,704 patients were followed up and received monthly treatment for their non-communicable diseases. Also among them, 1,635 under 5 girls and boys received routine immunization and growth monitoring services. Beyond the primary healthcare level, 420 referrals to secondary, tertiary and emergency care were provided to those in need among them 40 referrals were life-saving emergencies.

Within the resilience component, 25 primary healthcare facilities in Greater Cairo, Alexandria, received support while 72 healthcare professionals received training on family planning and post-abortion care as well as on data collection principles.
