
SCENARIO


2015: July 31st Tropical Cyclone Komen Landfall in Bangladesh. Partly responsible for widespread flooding in Rakhine, Chin and Sagaing States in Myanmar.

2013: May 14th Cyclone Mahasen Landfall in Sri Lanka and Banladesh. 35,550 people were relocated from Sittwe, Minbya, Myauk U, Kyauktaw, Rathedaung, Myebon and Pauktaw.


2010: October 22nd Cyclone Giri Category 4 cyclone made landfall in Rakhine State, close to the town of Kyaukpyu. The Townships of Kyaukpyu, Myebon, Minbya and Pauktaw were the most severely impacted. 45 people died and an estimated 260,000 were


Likelihood of storm activity in the Bay of Bengal



HOUSEHOLD SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER (%)




Household with safe sanitation vs unsafe sanitation (%)




