Shelter UNHCR	Nothing to report.
Non Food Items UNHCR-DRC	The Relief and Resettlement Department of the Ministry of Social Welfare has requested UNHCR support by way of distribution of NFIs to ten camps in Sittwe township. The distribution will cover more than 10,000 households. It is planned that this distribution will start after the HH survey ends. Dar Pai will be one of the first camps targeted for the distribution.
WASH Solidarites International	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 15 latrines with concrete floor replacement are under completion and planned to be functional by the beginning of April; - Latrine renovation activities that were planned to start during the two second weeks of March have been delayed until April; - 23 latrine pit rings found to be hazardous are under replacement with completion expected beginning of April; - Borehole rehabilitation campaign has been completed; - Regular water-testing at household- and borehole-level; - Latrine desludging is running normally; - Regular weekly mass cleaning campaign and waste management is carried out; - Regular hygiene promotion sessions at HH-level; - Regular borehole maintenance on-going; - On-going drainage cleaning campaigns; - FGD with protection partner (IRC) and women user groups have been held to ensure appropriate positioning of the lighting at latrine-level. The installation is ongoing and will run through the month of April;
Health IRC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Health profiling data-collection on-going; - Regular activities on-going.
Nutrition ACF-SCI	Nothing was reported.
Education LWF	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All schools are closed for vacation until the final exams have finished.

Livelihood DRC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - IPA distribution; - Cash management & book keeping training at the end of April; - Regular monitoring on livelihood activities on-going.
Protection DRC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Protection monitoring is on-going; - Protection Team will continue working with PSNs in the camps and following up on them; - Regular activities on-going.
Child Protection SCI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First week of April, Forum Theatre will take place at the Child Friendly Spaces. This strong tool is used to develop a sense of trust between the facilitator and the children, so children feel safe to express issues and take part in the "theatre". The methodology allows children to present an issue that is selected by a group of children as the issue most relevant to them. By working, and presenting in a group no individual child is stigmatized as the one raising the "issue" or the "problem". - Child Protection group meeting on April 28 at Child Protection office.
Security and Safety	<p>It was reported during a meeting with women's group that there have been cases of chicken pox in PYG village, STMG camp, and also in OTG-N where 18 cases were confirmed by Mercy Malaysia. The Clinics in the camps have been informed as well as protection partners, however if you have further information, please contact CCCM or Protection partners.</p>
