Shelter UNHCR	A briefing session for the Shelter situation in Rakhine will be held by the National CCCM-Shelter-NFI Cluster on March 10 in Yangon.
Non Food Items UNHCR-DRC	The Relief and Resettlement Department of the Ministry of Social Welfare has requested UNHCR support by way of distribution of NFIs to ten camps in Sittwe township. The distribution will cover more than 10,000 households. It is planned that this distribution will start on the 17th of March. Dar Pai will be one of the first camps targeted for the distribution.

Renovation activities will restart during the third week of March and run through April. - Latrine renovation activities will restart during the second two weeks of March and run through April. - Borehole rehabilitation campaign is ongoing and will be completed by mid-march. - Meeting with CMC's and women users groups have been held to ensure appropriate positioning of the lighting around latrines. The installation will be done during the month of March. - Regular activities on-going
