

Camp Level Update	
Camp Management Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the monthly meeting between CMC and camp management the issue of limited health support was raised. The mobile clinic is are only operating two days a week for two hours each visit, the CMC would like to utilize the available Community Health Workers to provide health support for IDPs and requested that some medicine and drugs can be made available for the 5 CHWs. CMC reported the damage to the camp jetty and requested support for the repairs required. Additional requests related to the need for latrine renovation, the lack of food ration and nutrition for new born babies and fencing of the ponds. Also discussed is the need for shelter occupancy verification and concern from the CMC that a number of agencies are only coordinating activities in the camp with the sub-committees and not the CMC. CM team will facilitate inter-agency and CMC coordination. The CM team initiated discussion with CMC regarding IDPs movements to and from KNP SCI food distribution conducted at KNP camp on February 11th, food package includes Rice, Pulse, Oil and Salt for a total of 4,683 IDPs.
