Document has been in development since May 2015 and is the product of discussions (as well as consultations) between the Protection Sector and CCCM Cluster. A workshop was held on 7 <sup>th</sup> July 2015 with participants from Kachin and Northern Shan where the document was finalised. It touched on particular issues and potential activities that could be undertaken to address concerns relating to the civilian character of the camps.  Before circulating it more widely the document was presented to the senior management of CMA in order that they review it and offer an in depth					
feedback.
