

# **Burundi RRRP and Congo CP**

# PROTECTION

---

- The withdrawal of the prima facie recognition, institution of immigration screening and implication on access to Tanzanian territory
- Consolidation of entry points in Kigoma region limiting to access to territory
- Refugee Status Determination (RSD)

# EDUCATION

---

- Access to pre-primary education services, out of school children and the country of origin curriculum policy.
- Provision of *alternative pathways to formal education* in order to provide access to education for the estimated **21,940 OOS** children and youth as well as **13,924** overage learners.

## HEALTH

---

- Gaps: Inadequate health care facilities, stock out of essential medicine, compromised preventive and preparedness programs, and access to Nutrition facilities.
- RRRP: Add and emphasis on nutrition surveillance, supplementary and therapeutic feeding programs will be continued to maintain the nutrition status of the under five year children

# WASH

---

- Improved backup systems (more generators and pumps which are continually breaking down)
- Search for additional groundwater sources and less reliance on surface water

## SHELTER

---

66% continue to reside in Emergency shelters and tents which are in poor condition. There is need for additional funding for transitional shelter provision.

- Burundi RRRP: Focus on upgrading shelters to semi-permanent.
- DRC CP: Land is a primary need in particular for asylum seekers
